



LEAVE OF ABSENCE DOCTOR OF NURSING PRACTICE DNP

Any DNP student who leaves the University for reasons approved by the Director of the DNP Program of the *School of Nursing and Health Sciences (SNHS)* with the intention of returning is considered to be on leave of absence.

Procedure

Any DNP student who wishes to apply for a leave of absence from the DNP or PMHNP certification programs must notify in writing his/her course instructor, academic nursing advisor, and/or the program director in the graduate program.

If the absence is longer than 4 terms, including summer term, a student in good standing must request reinstatement by sending a written request to the DNP program director. A determination will be made by the DNP Council.
