Admission Requirements for High School Graduates

Application

All students seeking to enroll as first-time freshmen must submit an official RMU application

Transcripts

- Official high school transcripts showing all grades and GPA, or a General Equivalency Diploma (GED), must be submitted
 - The official transcript must confirm completed work equal to a standard high school course with a minimum of 16 units, including the following:
 - 4 units of English
 - 3 units of Social Studies
 - 2 units of Mathematics
 - 1 unit must be Algebra
 - 2 units of Science with a related laboratory
 - 1 unit must be Chemistry with a related laboratory
 - 5 units academic electives
 - The official transcript must confirm letter grades of B or better in math and science courses
- Students who completed any post-secondary coursework must submit official transcripts from those institutions, in addition to the high school transcript

Standardized Test Scores & Grade Point Average (GPA)

- For students with standardized test scores
 - 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
 - o 1080 minimum SAT score or
 - o 22 minimum ACT composite score
- For students without standardized test scores
 - 3.4 GPA on a 4.0 scale

Applications may be subject to review on an individual basis within the Department of Nursing
