



COMPLETION OF PROGRAM: RN TO BSN

- The RN to BSN nursing program is a part-time program.
- Students who are enrolled in the program will have a variety of core courses to complete.
- The number of core courses that need to be taken by a student will affect the length of program completion and will vary dependent upon transfer credits accepted.
- Once the core courses have been completed, students typically finish the BSN curriculum in less than 2 years, taking 2 courses each semester (Fall, Spring and Summer).
- Students who are being reinstated must adhere to the academic policy, [Undergraduate Reinstatement Policy](#)
- The expected completion of the nursing program should be no longer than (5) years from the time the student first enrolls in a University course.
