Top Story - The Robert Morris University men's basketball team returns home to the Charles L. Sewall Center for a two-game homestand this week, starting Thursday with a 7:00 p.m. Northeast Conference contest against Fairleigh Dickinson. The Colonials are coming off a 76-68 defeat @ Monmouth (1/27/07) in their last contest and currently reside in a tie for sixth place in the league standings with Wagner. RMU will close out its 2006-07 regular season with five of its final eight games at home, where the club has posted a record of 8-1 this season and 19-3 dating back to the start of the 2005-06 campaign. Robert Morris closes out its homestand Saturday, Feb. 3, when it welcomes in-state rival Saint Francis (Pa.) for a 3:30 p.m. tilt that will be broadcast live on Fox Sports Net Pittsburgh and Fox College Sports (Atlantic).

Quick Stat of the Night - Robert Morris will look to rediscover the defensive intensity the club employed with the dawn of the new year as the club enters its final month of regular-season action Thursday against Fairleigh Dickinson. In a five-game stretch from Dec. 30, 2006, to Jan. 13, 2007, RMU held its opponents to a shooting percentage of just 38.5 percent (100-for-260), posting a 4-1 record over that time frame. However, in the last four contests, a span in which Robert Morris has gone 2-2, opponents have converted 57.1 percent (120-for-210) of its field goals, including a mark of 46.7 percent (35-for-75) from beyond the arc.

Thursday's Opponent and the All-Time Series -RMU and Fairleigh Dickinson will tipoff for the 56th time Thursday night, with the Knights holding a 29-26 edge in the all-time series. FDU had won four straight over the Colonials in the all-time series until Robert Morris garnered a 70-66 win in the first meeting between the two

Head Coach Mark Schmidt Sixth Season - Boston College '85



The 2006-07 campaign marks **Mark Schmidt's** sixth year as head coach of the men's basketball program at Robert Morris University. He owns an overall record of 78-85 (.479), including a 54-48 (.529) mark in the Northeast Conference, and was named to his current post May 7, 2001. Schmidt guided the Colonials to their first winning season in six years in 2005-06 with an overall record of 15-14, including 10-8 in conference action. He also led RMU to the NEC Tournament semifinals for the second time in the last three years in 2006. In 2003-04 and 2004-05, he led RMU to identical overall

records of 14-15. In 2001-02, Schmidt led Robert Morris to a 12-18 overall record, the most victories for a first-year head coach in the 30-year history of the Colonial men's basketball program.

Prior to RMU, Schmidt spent seven seasons as one of the nation's top assistants at Xavier University under current Wake Forest head coach Skip Prosser from 1994-2001. While with the Musketeers, Schmidt played a dual role, serving as both a coach and the program's top recruiter. His coaching responsibilities centered mostly around the post players, and he helped develop and recruit players at Xavier that have moved on to the professional ranks, including James Posey (Miami Heat), David West (New Orleans Hornets), Romain Sato (San Antonio Spurs), Lionel Chalmers (Minnesota Timberwolves) and David Young (Seattle Supersonics). Prior to his stint with Xavier, Schmidt served one year as an assistant at Loyola College in Baltimore, Md., also under Prosser. He also spent two seasons at Penn State University under Bruce Parkhill from 1991-93, and started his coaching career as an assistant at St. Michael's College in Vermont from 1989-91.

Schmidt's playing career was highlighted by four years as a guard/forward at Boston College, where he received his bachelor's degree in business administration and management with a concentration in marketing in 1985. The Eagles went 22-10 and made the NCAA Elite Eight during his freshman season in 1981-82 under head coach Tom Davis and 25-7 the next year in making the NCAA Tournament Sweet Sixteen in his first of three years playing for current Maryland coach Gary Williams. Boston College reached the NIT second round in 1984 and the NCAA Sweet Sixteen again in 1985.

Scouting the Knights - Fairleigh Dickinson owns an overall record of 10-10 entering Thursday's game with RMU, including a record of 5-4 in Northeast Conference play. Senior forward Andre Harris is the only player in the league this year to score in double figures in every contest and leads the conference in scoring with an 18.2 points per game average. Harris also is the club's leading rebounder (7.6 per game), a total that ranks second in the NEC. Sophomore point guard Cameron Tyler, meanwhile, averages 13.5 points per game while ranking third in the circuit by averaging 5.10 assists per contest.

Fairleigh Dickinson Head Coach - The dean of Northeast Conference coaches, **Tom Green** (**Syracuse** '**71**) is in his 24th season as head coach of the Knights. He owns a career record of 388-302 (.562), all with Fairleigh Dickinson, and is the all-time NEC wins leader.

RMU's Last Game - Dejan Delic hit four three-pointers in the last 5:21 of the contest to help propel Monmouth to a 76-68 victory over Robert Morris Jan. 27. Senior guard Derek Coleman opened the game's scoring with a three-pointer, one of five trifecta's in the first six and-a-half minutes of play as RMU built a 19-13 lead. Coleman and sophomore guard Jeremy Chappell each hit a pair during the salvo, while junior guard Tony Lee added another. The Colonials eventually pushed their lead to eight on a pair of occasions, both on jumpers from senior forward A.J. Jackson. Lee gave Robert Morris a 30-21 advantage with a three-pointer at the 7:09 mark of the first half, but John Bunch came back to score on a dunk to close Monmouth within seven, 30-23. Chappell answered Bunch's dunk with a layup on a putback of his own missed shot, and after a scramble for a loose ball went out of bounds on the next Hawk possession, the ball was given to Robert Morris. Monmouth head coach Dave Calloway was called for a technical foul after the play, and Coleman promptly sank both of his free throws to give RMU a 34-23 edge with 4:37 left before the break. However, RMU went cold offensively the rest of the half, going 0-for-5 from the field while committing four turnovers. In the process the Hawks scored 13 unanswered points to take a 36-34 lead with 56 ticks left on the first-half clock. Robert Morris was able to send the game tied into the break at 36-36 when freshman guard Mezie Nwigwe hit a pair of free throws. Jhamar Youngblood opened the second half scoring with a threepointer to give the Hawks a 39-36 edge, but Chappell answered Youngblood's trifecta with a jumper, and his jumper with 16 minutes to go pulled RMU within one, 43-42. However, on the next possession Corey Hallett appeared to have his shot blocked by Chappell, but he was called for the foul. Chappell then picked up a technical for disagreeing with the call, pushing his infraction total to five and forcing him to sit out the last 15:42 of the contest. The game remained a close affair until Delic's three-pointer with 5:21 to go pushed the Hawks in front, 61-59. The Colonials answered with a three-pointer of their own, this time from junior forward Colson Sénat, but Delic hit from long range again to give Monmouth the lead for good, 64-62, with 3:21 remaining.

Monmouth Game Notes - Robert Morris hit on five of its first seven opportunities from beyond the arc in the first six minutes of play but finished 4-for-15 the rest of the game ... RMU held a 38-25 advantage on the backboard, including a 16-8 edge on the offensive glass ... The Colonials committed 20 turnovers on the game and were outscored, 35-7, in points off turnovers ... Sophomore guard Jeremy Chappell scored 16 points in just 21 minutes of action before fouling out with 15:43 to play ... Senior forward A.J. Jackson and senior guard Derek Coleman each logged a full 40 minutes worth of action ... RMU posted 14 assists on its 24 field goals ... Robert Morris posted a free-throw shooting percentage of 84.6 percent (11-for-13), the ninth time in 19 games this season the club has shot 80 percent or better from the charity stripe ... Sophomore guard Mezie Nwigwe scored five points in 21 minutes, with all five points coming courtesy of the free-throw line.

Offensively Speaking - Robert Morris enters Thursday night's game against Fairleigh Dickinson having seemingly hit its stride offensively, as the club has shot a solid 50.1 percent (310-for-619) from the field in its last 11 games. Over that span the Colonials have shot 50 percent or better from the field six times. Due to the surge, RMU owns a team shooting percentage of 47.1 percent (518-for-1,100) on the season, which ranks second in the Northeast Conference despite being tied with Sacred Heart and Monmouth. The Colonials have never lead the league in field goal percentage in 26 years as part of the conference.

Balance Beam - In the first 10 games of the 2006-07 Northeast Conference schedule for Robert Morris this season, the Colonials have received about as balanced scoring as you could possibly witness. A total of 16 points separates RMU's leading scorer in league games to its fourth highest scorer. Senior forward A.J. Jackson (159 points) leads the club in scoring in NEC tilts at 15.9 points per game, while senior guard Derek Coleman ranks fourth (14.3 ppg) with 143 points.

Combination Platter - So far this season, Robert Morris has received 77.1 percent of its offense from its usual contributors in guards **Derek Coleman**, **Tony Lee** and **Jeremy Chappell** and forward **A.J. Jackson**. Despite that, dating back to the start of the 2005-06 campaign, when Coleman and Jackson combine to score more than 30 points in a game, the Colonials own a record of **16-4** (.**800**). Included in that is a mark of 7-1 so far this season, with the only loss against Sacred Heart (1/18/07).

The Patriot - Any success Robert Morris will have in the second half of its 2006-07 Northeast Conference season will depend in large part to the play of senior guard Derek Coleman. A natural playmaker, the Boston, Mass., product has also increased his offensive production since the calendar has switched to the year 2007. In eight games since returning to league play, Coleman is averaging 15.3 points per contest while shooting 50.6 percent (41-for-81) from the floor. Even with the increased offensive output, it hasn't slowed Coleman down in creating opportunities for his teammates. In the same stretch Coleman is averaging 6.0 assists per game, a big reason he leads the circuit in NEC games in the category (6.2 apg).

Tuned In - A key reason senior guard Derek Coleman has seen a surge offensively in recent weeks is due in large part to his three-point shooting. After hitting on just 38.8 percent (26-for-67) of his shots from long range in the first 14 games of the 2006-07 campaign, Coleman is shooting 50 percent (17-for-34) from beyond the arc in his last five games. The outburst now has Coleman ranked fourth in the NEC in three-point field goal percentage (42.6 percent).

Putting It All Together - Despite playing just 21 minutes due to fouling out @ Monmouth (1/27/07), sophomore guard Jeremy Chappell seems to be saving his best for the home stretch of the 2006-07 campaign. Over the last three games Chappell has posted solid numbers across the board, scoring at a 17.3 points per game clip while adding averages of 4.3 rebounds, 4.3 assists and 3.0 steals per contest. More importantly, Chappell seems to be finding his shooting touch. Over that same time span Chappell has converted 53.8 percent (21-for-39) of his shots from the floor.

Both Ends of the Floor - Junior guard Tony Lee has been the most complete player for Robert Morris in 2006-07, and the evidence is in the numbers. Offensively, Lee ranks second for Robert Morris in scoring (15.4 ppg) while pacing the Northeast Conference in field goal percentage (.614). Defensively, Lee also leads the circuit in steals by averaging 2.84 per game. In the national rankings through games of Jan. 28, 2007, Lee ranks ninth in Division I in steals, while his field goal percentage ranks 18th. He is the only player from an NEC school to rank in the 20 top in two categories. A look at the numbers ...

Triple Threat - With junior guard Tony Lee leading the Northeast Conference in field goal percentage (61.4 percent) while ranking fifth in assists (4.3 per game), it has him approaching a milestone few have accomplished in the history of the league. With career totals of 873 points, 478 rebounds and 228 assists, Lee has an outside shot this season of becoming just the fifth player in league history to eclipse career totals of 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 250 assists. The last player to turn the trick was Kason Mims of Quinnipiac, who finished his career with 1,335 points, 548 caroms and 453 assists. If Lee were to eclipse those totals this season, he would be the first of the five to accomplish the feat as a junior.

Paint by Numbers - RMU's shooting woes from beyond the three-point arc in recent weeks has been well documented, yet despite those struggles the Colonials have begun to balance out their offense. Robert Morris enters Thursday's game against Fairleigh Dickinson having outscored its opponent, 366-272, in points in the paint in its last 11 games. As a whole RMU has done a more than adequate job of working the ball inside so far in 2006-07, averaging 32.9 points in the paint this season and outscoring their opponent in the category in 12 of its first 19 tilts.

Mr. Perfect - Junior guard Tony Lee certainly could be looked at as RMU's most valuable player as the club is off to a 13-6 start to the 2006-07 season, and he probably was never more valuable in a game than in an 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/06). Lee finished a perfect 8-for-8 from the field, including 1-for-1 from beyond the arc, in scoring 17 points while adding a team high seven rebounds, four assists and two steals. The only other perfect day for a Robert Morris player on record with more than five field goal attempts was former Colonial Bubba Donnelly (1991-95), who finished 7-for-7 from the field for 21 points in an 80-59 win @ Rider (1/10/94). All seven of Donnelly's field goals in that game were three-pointers.

The Encore - While junior guard Tony Lee nailed all eight of his shots from the field in RMU's 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/06), freshman guard Jimmy Langhurst provided the encore in an 83-38 win over Division III Goucher (12/30/06). Langhurst hit all four of his shots from the field, including two from long range, and sank all four of his free-throw opportunities in producing a career high 14 points and finishing second on the club in scoring against the Gophers. Possibly the purest shooter on the club, Langhurst has hit on 60 percent (6-of-10) of his shots this season, including three of his five opportunities from downtown.

Straight Shooter - Junior guard Tony Lee hit his first six shots from the field in RMU's 83-38 win over Goucher (12/30/06) before missing a three-pointer with a minute to go in the first half. With that missed trifecta it ended a streak of 16 straight field goals for Lee dating back to the club's 79-78 win over Youngstown State (12/16/06). Lee hit his last two field goals against the Penguins, all eight of his shots in an 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/06) before hitting his first six shots from the floor against the Gophers.

Hard to Imagine - A very important part to senior guard Derek Coleman's offensive output over his four-year career has been the ability to knock down the three-point shot. Coleman owns 184 three-pointers on his career, which ranks fifth all-time at Robert Morris. However, in RMU's 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/04), Coleman finished with 14 points despite not hitting a three-pointer. He finished 4-for-10 from the field and a perfect 6-for-6 from the free-throw line for his 14 points but was 0-for-4 from beyond the arc. It marks the first time in his career Coleman, with 45 career double-figure scoring games to his credit, finished in double digits without hitting a three-pointer.

The Strokes - Despite an 0-for-4 performance from beyond the arc in an 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/04), it didn't stop **Derek Coleman** from coming through when RMU needed him most. Coleman finished 6-for-6 from the free-throw line against the Golden Griffins, including 4-for-4 in the last 34 seconds to help seal the victory. Coleman owns a free-throw shooting percentage of 87.5 percent (42-for-48) so far this season, which ranks second in the Northeast Conference. Coleman could possibly be making runs at both the single-season and career records for free throw shooting. The single-season mark is held by former Colonial Brandon Welsch, who converted 87.7 percent of his shots in 1998-99. The career record of 86 percent is held by former Colonial Tom Parks (1978-83). Coleman enters Thursday's game against Fairleigh Dickinson with a career free-throw shooting percentage of 82.7 percent (163-for-197), which ranks third in the career annals at Robert Morris.

Select Company - Senior forward A.J. Jackson, a 2006-07 preseason All-Northeast Conference Team selection, put together one of his best games in a Colonial uniform in RMU's 73-69 win @ Marshall (11/17/06). Jackson finished with 30 points on 9-of-18 shooting and also compiled 15 rebounds, including six offensive boards, for his 15th career double-double. His 30-point effort marks the second time Jackson has hit the 30-point plateau in a contest, while his 15 rebounds marks the third time he has recorded at least 15 caroms in a game. A quick glance at the Robert Morris single-game records, and Jackson has an opportunity to post the most 30-point scoring games in school history and is already tied for the most games with 15+rebounds. Former Colonial Myron Walker (1991-94) posted six games in which he scored 30 or more points, while former Colonials Earl Cureton (1976-77) and Anthony Dickens (1985-90) own three games of posting at least 15 rebounds in a game. Clutch Shooting - A number of Colonials have begun to show their penchant for clutch shooting late in ball games as Robert Morris enters the second half of the 2006-07 campaign. In a 73-69 victory @ Marshall (11/17/06) in the club's first road game of the season, senior forward A.J. Jackson and senior guard Derek Coleman each hit three-pointers in the last 1:35 of the contest to help propel the Colonials to victory. Coleman's three-pointer with 49 seconds to go gave Robert Morris the lead for good, and it marks his second career three-pointer in the last minute of a game that gave the Colonials a lead. Coleman drained a three-pointer with 12 seconds to play to lift RMU to a 69-68 victory @ Central Connecticut State (2/14/04) during his freshman campaign. Sophomore guard Jeremy Chappell, meanwhile, sunk a three-pointer with 12.3 seconds remaining to lift Robert Morris to a 67-66 win @ Mount St. Mary's (3/3/06) in the 2006 NEC Tournament quarterfinals.

RMU Weekly Honors - Senior forward A.J. Jackson (Northeast Conference Choice Hotels Player of the Week - 11/20/06) ... Senior forward A.J. Jackson (NEC Choice Hotels Player of the Week - 11/27/06) ... Junior guard Tony Lee (NEC Choice Hotels Player of the Week - 12/18/06) ... Junior guard Tony Lee (NEC Choice Hotels Player of the Week - 1/2/07).

Running With the Devil - Robert Morris has played some close ball games so far on the 2006-07 season, with the Colonials coming out on top. In games decided by five points or less RMU boasts a record of 6-2, including a pair of one-point victories. That mark has helped Robert Morris improve to 27-20 (.574) under sixth-year head coach Mark Schmidt in games decided by five points or less. However, basketball is a game of runs, and that has never been more prudent than with Robert Morris in 2006-07. In 18 of RMU's 19 games so far this season, the Colonials have either owned a double-digit lead or trailed by double digits.

Iron Man - Senior guard Derek Coleman doesn't get comfortable sitting on the bench during games. In fact, he rarely is off the court at all. Coleman enters Thursday's game @ Fairleigh Dickinson having played a full contest in nine of the club's 19 games this season, and in two other contests he has logged 39 minutes. It's a trend that hasn't subsided for RMU's floor general since he became a regular starter for the club at the end of his freshman season. Coleman has played a full game's worth of action a total of 32 times in his Robert Morris career, including a pair of 45-minute stints thanks to overtime games. Since earning his first start against Sacred Heart back on Feb. 5, 2004, Coleman has averaged 35.9 minutes per game in 87 starts.

Making It Count - An area of strength for RMU under the direction of head coach Mark Schmidt has been the ability of the team to convert at the free-throw line. Robert Morris has finished in the top five in the Northeast Conference in free-throw percentage each of the previous five years, including a league-best 75.4 percent (384-for-576) in 2003-04. So far this season the Colonials rank second in the circuit in free throw percentage, converting 73.2 percent (230-for-314) of their opportunities. Robert Morris has been even better in pressure situations, converting a solid 81.1 percent (73-for-90) of its shots in the last five minutes and overtime of games. Senior guard Derek Coleman and senior forward A.J. Jackson have been at the stripe the most in crunch time, combining to hit 32 of their 37 opportunities (86.5 percent).

Pop Goes the Weasel - Junior guard Tony Lee was all over the court in RMU's 73-72 win over Duquesne (12/2/06), especially on defense. Lee broke a 19-year old Charles L. Sewall Center record for steals by registering eight against the Dukes, including three in the last 12:07 as RMU climbed out of a 10-point deficit. Lee's eight steals eclipsed the old record of seven, which was originally established by Drafton Davis of Marist. Davis recorded his seven thefts in a 61-57 overtime victory over the Colonials Feb. 28, 1987. Lee's eight steals is the sixth highest single-game total of the 2006-07 season in Division I, behind Travis Holmes of VMI (11 steals), Ledell Eackles of Campbell (10 steals) and Darren Collison of UCLA, Damian Martin of Loyola Marymount and Chavis Holmes of VMI, who each have posted nine steals.

Creating & Creating - Senior guard Derek Coleman, who proved himself an accurate three-point shooter in 2005-06, has done a solid job this year doing what he does best: creating opportunities for his teammates. Coleman dished out nine assists in a 77-64 win over New Hampshire (11/21/06), pushing his career total to 306 dimes, just the ninth Colonial in school history to dish out over 300 career assists. After entering this season ranked 11th all-time at Robert Morris for assists, Coleman now ranks sixth all-time. Coleman currently is tops in the Northeast Conference in assists per game (5.42).

Spread The Jam - One of the strength's for Robert Morris on the 2006-07 campaign has been the club's ability to be unselfish, and it's a trend that has continued as the Colonials have returned to league play. In the last 11 contests RMU has converted a total of 310 field goals, with the club posting assists on 183 of those baskets. That equates to almost 60 percent (59.0) of the club's field goals. As a club so far this year Robert Morris is averaging 16.21 assists per game, which leads the Northeast Conference. The highest assist per game average by RMU in the six-year tenure of head coach Mark Schmidt is 15.2 dimes per contest, set in Schmidt's inaugural season as head coach in 2001-02.

Daytona 500 - While junior guard Tony Lee has an outside shot of joining the 1,000-point club this season, barring injury he should almost assuredly eclipse the 500-rebound plateau. Lee enters Thursday's game with 478 career caroms, which ranks 19th all-time at Robert Morris. At his current pace (6.4 rpg), Lee is on pace to push his career total for rebounds to 529 by the end of the 2006-07 regular season, at total that would rank 10th all-time. There are currently 12 members in the 500-rebound club at Robert Morris.

The Chase Is On - For the second time in three seasons, the Robert Morris career record for three-point field goals could be challenged in 2006-07. Former Colonial Aaron Thomas (2000-04) established a new career record for three-pointers in 2003-04 by finishing his career with 218. That record was only 48 treys ahead of former Colonial Maurice Carter (2001-05) entering the 2004-05 campaign, but Carter hit just 47 in his senior season to finish second in the record books with 217 career three-pointers. Now, thanks to a career high 74 three-pointers in 2005-06, senior Derek Coleman entered his final season in 2006-07 a total of 78 three-pointers shy of breaking the record held by Thomas. Coleman owns 43 three-pointers so far on the 2006-07 season, pushing his career total to 184, which ranks fifth all-time at RMU. With eight regular-season games remaining in 2006-07, Coleman needs 35 three-pointers to eclipse the record of 218 held by Thomas. Over that span Coleman will need to average 4.4 three-pointers per game.

Home Is Where the Heart Is - Senior forward A.J. Jackson has found the Charles L. Sewall Center to his liking. Dating back to the start of the 2005-06 campaign, Jackson has been as solid a player as any for the Colonials at home, averaging 18.6 points and 9.5 rebounds in 22 career games at the Sewall Center. Jackson became just the second Colonial in school history to average over 20 points per game at home last season when he scored at a 20.8 points per game clip. The only other Colonial to average over 20 points per contest in a season in the Sewall Center's 22-year history was RMU all-time leading scorer Myron Walker (1990-94), who averaged 21.1 points per game as a sophomore in 1991-92. Jackson also has an opportunity to post the best career scoring average by a Colonial at the Sewall Center. That mark is also held by Walker at 18.5 points per game. Jackson**, junior guard **Tony Lee** and sophomore guard **Jeremy Chappell**. While Chappell is well on his way to becoming a 1,000-point scorer at RMU after a freshman campaign in which he was named the 2006 NEC Rookie of the Year, Coleman, Jackson and Lee each entered this season with outside shots of joining RMU's 1,000-point club. Topping the list for the third time in the last four years is Robert Morris, which features senior forward **A.J. Jackson** and sophomore guard **Jeremy Chappell**. The duo, led by Jackson's 17.0 ppg average in 2005-06, combined to average 31.1 ppg last season. Chappell averaged 14.1 points per game as a freshman in 2005-06. Entering the 2003-04 and 2004-05 campaigns, Robert Morris had the top returning scoring duo thanks to former forward Chaz McCrommon and former guard Maurice Carter. The top mark by an NEC returning scoring duo was McCrommon and Carter, who averaged 35.5 points game entering 2003-04.

Home Sweet Home - Robert Morris has learned to protect its home court at the Charles L. Sewall Center, as the Colonials notched a 96-72 win in its 2006-07 season opener over Florida International at home, a year after posting an 11-2 record at home. Thanks to an 8-1 record at the Sewall Center so far this season, RMU has posted a record of 49-24 (.671) at the home under sixth-year head coach Mark Schmidt. Overall in the 22-year history of the facility the Colonials have posted a record of 172-105 (.621).

Four on the Floor - Senior forward A.J. Jackson had his streak of 20+ point scoring games snapped at four when he finished with just eight points @ Monmouth (1/27/07). Despite that, it marked Jackson's second such streak of the 2006-07 season. In RMU's 4-0 start to the year, Jackson averaged 24.0 points per game and eclipsed the 20-point plateau in each contest. He became the first Colonial in school history to post a pair of streaks of at least four games scoring 20+ points in the same season and just the second player to turn the trick overall. Former Colonial Gene Nabors (1995-2000) also accomplished the feat twice, turning the trick in each of the 1998-99 and 1999-2000 campaigns. Jackson is also just the fifth player in school history to score at least 20 points in four straight games overall, as joining him and Nabors are former Colonials Myron Walker (1990-94), Keith Jones (1995-99) and Wesley Fluellen (1997-2002). Nabors is also the only Colonial in school history to have more than four games of scoring 20+ points in a contest, as he averaged 27.1 points over eight straight games late in the 1999-2000 season. 2006 Northeast Conference Preseason Coaches Poll

According to a poll of league head coaches, Robert Morris was been picked to finish second in the Northeast Conference in 2006-07. It marks the highest preseason ranking for the Colonials ever, matching their second-place preseason prediction prior to the 1991-92 campaign. RMU received five firstplace votes, with the other six going to Monmouth, which was tabbed as the preseason favorite.

Following Monmouth and Robert Morris in the top five in the poll are Long Island, Central Connecticut State and Quinnipiac. The Blue Devils and Bobcats were picked to tie for fourth in the poll. Rounding out the annual poll is Wagner, Fairleigh Dickinson, St. Francis (N.Y.), Sacred Heart, Mount St. Mary's and Saint Francis (Pa.).

As well as being picked second in the preseason poll, Robert Morris placed senior forward A.J. Jackson on the 2006-07 NEC preseason all-conference team. Joining Jackson are forwards Margues Alston of Monmouth and Obie Nwadike of Central Connecticut State and guards Jarrid Frye of Sacred Heart and James Williams of Long Island.

Conducted annually, NEC coaches have failed to correctly forecast the eventual league champion since selecting Mount St. Mary's to win it all in 1998-99, and have proven inaccurate in 17 of the last 19 years.

This year marks the eighth time that Monmouth has been selected the Northeast Conference's preseason favorite by league head coaches, the most in conference history by a wide margin.

The Need for Three

The Colonials have relied heavily on the three-point shot under the direction of Mark Schmidt during his six years as head coach, with evidence the club's three-point field goal totals. In 2005-06 RMU shattered the team record for three-pointers with 260, eclipsing the club's old mark of 213, which was set in 2003-04. On the 2005-06 campaign, RMU averaged 8.97 three-pointers a game to lead the Northeast Conference. Since the start of the 2001-02 season, the Colonials lead the NEC in three-pointers made per game (7.48), ahead of St. Francis (N.Y.), which has averaged 7.09 three-pointers a contest.
