Top Story - The Robert Morris University men's basketball team closes out a two-game homestand Saturday afternoon by hosting in-state rival Saint Francis (Pa.) for a 3:30 p.m. Northeast Conference contest that will be broadcast live on Fox Sports Net Pittsburgh and Fox Sports College Atlantic. The Colonials are coming off an 84-79 loss to Fairleigh Dickinson (2/1/07) to open the homestand and will look to snap a two-game slide. RMU has yet to drop three straight games this season, dropping back-to-back games only twice. Robert Morris takes to the road for its next game, visiting Mount St. Mary's Saturday, Feb. 10, for a 7:00 p.m. tilt.

Quick Stat of the Night - The Colonials will look to snap a two-game skid Saturday against a club they have had success against in recent seasons. Robert Morris has won four straight in the all-time series against Saint Francis (Pa.), marking the best such streak against a Northeast Conference opponent in the six years Mark Schmidt has headed up the program. The Colonials will also carry a four-game winning streak against Quinnipiac Feb. 24, 2007. Against the Red Flash over the last four games RMU is averaging 78.8 points per game while shooting 53.2 percent (113-for-216) from the field, including an even 50 percent (38-for-76) from beyond the arc.

Saturday's Opponent and the All-Time Series -

Robert Morris and Saint Francis (Pa.) will hit the hardwood for the 61st time Saturday afternoon, with RMU holding a 33-27 edge in the alltime series. Head Coach Mark Schmidt Sixth Season - Boston College '85



The 2006-07 campaign marks **Mark Schmidt's** sixth year as head coach of the men's basketball program at Robert Morris University. He owns an overall record of 78-86 (.476), including a 54-49 (.524) mark in the Northeast Conference, and was named to his current post May 7, 2001. Schmidt guided the Colonials to their first winning season in six years in 2005-06 with an overall record of 15-14, including 10-8 in conference action. He also led RMU to the NEC Tournament semifinals for the second time in the last three years in 2006. In 2003-04 and 2004-05, he led RMU to identical overall

records of 14-15. In 2001-02, Schmidt led Robert Morris to a 12-18 overall record, the most victories for a first-year head coach in the 30-year history of the Colonial men's basketball program.

Prior to RMU, Schmidt spent seven seasons as one of the nation's top assistants at Xavier University under current Wake Forest head coach Skip Prosser from 1994-2001. While with the Musketeers, Schmidt played a dual role, serving as both a coach and the program's top recruiter. His coaching responsibilities centered mostly around the post players, and he helped develop and recruit players at Xavier that have moved on to the professional ranks, including James Posey (Miami Heat), David West (New Orleans Hornets), Romain Sato (San Antonio Spurs), Lionel Chalmers (Minnesota Timberwolves) and David Young (Seattle Supersonics). Prior to his stint with Xavier, Schmidt served one year as an assistant at Loyola College in Baltimore, Md., also under Prosser. He also spent two seasons at Penn State University under Bruce Parkhill from 1991-93, and started his coaching career as an assistant at St. Michael's College in Vermont from 1989-91.

Schmidt's playing career was highlighted by four years as a guard/forward at Boston College, where he received his bachelor's degree in business administration and management with a concentration in marketing in 1985. The Eagles went 22-10 and made the NCAA Elite Eight during his freshman season in 1981-82 under head coach Tom Davis and 25-7 the next year in making the NCAA Tournament Sweet Sixteen in his first of three years playing for current Maryland coach Gary Williams. Boston College reached the NIT second round in 1984 and the NCAA Sweet Sixteen again in 1985.

Scouting the Red Flash - Saint Francis (Pa.) enters Saturday's game with RMU sporting an overall record of 4-18, including 1-10 in Northeast Conference play, and has dropped 13 straight games dating back to a 70-56 win over Liberty (12/16/06). The leading scorer and rebounder for the Red Flash has been freshman guard Devin Sweetney, who averages 13.3 points per game and 7.5 caroms a contest. He also ranks third in the NEC in free-throw percentage, converting 85.1 percent (103-for-121) of his shots from the stripe.

Saint Francis (Pa.) Head Coach - Bobby Jones (Western Kentucky '84) is in his eighth season heading up the Red Flash men's basketball program and enters Saturday's game with an overall record of 77-141 (.353), all with St. Francis (Pa.). Prior to his first head coaching job, Jones was the associate head coach at Minnesota from 1997-99.

RMU's Last Game - Andre Harris scored 28 of his career high 34 points in the second half as Fairleigh Dickinson overcame a one-point halftime deficit to send Robert Morris to its second consecutive loss Feb. 1, 84-79. FDU jumped out of the gates to a 10-6 lead after jumper's from Harris and Michael Peeples and eventually stretched its lead to seven, 22-15. The Colonials clawed back to tie the game at 22-22 with 8:24 to play in the first half thanks to a jumper from freshman guard Mezie Nwigwe, an old-fashion three-point play from senior guard Derek Coleman and a jumper from sophomore guard Jeremy Chappell. The two clubs traded leads until Robert Morris hung a 6-0 spurt on Fairleigh Dickinson to take a 40-34 edge that was fueled by four points from Coleman and another jumper from Chappell. However, the Knights responded with an 8-2 surge to tie the game at 42-42. With RMU holding a 45-43 edge with less than 30 seconds remaining in the first half, senior forward A.J. Jackson scored on a dunk with 10 ticks left on the clock to give the Colonials a 47-43 advantage, but Manny Ubilla came back and drained a three-pointer as time expired in the first half to pull FDU within one at the break, 47-46. In the second half Harris took over, hitting shots all over the floor, including two from beyond the arc. His jumper with 14:21 to play gave the Knights a 61-55 lead, and his layup with 11:45 to go kept Fairleigh Dickinson ahead by six, 65-59. Robert Morris responded to take a 69-67 lead on the strength of a 10-2 surge that was fueled by five points from Chappell. His dunk after a steal by Jackson at center court gave RMU the lead, but after an FDU timeout Ubilla was fouled and hit two free throws to tie the score. 69-69. The back-and-forth affair continued as the game featured 17 ties, but the Colonials clawed in front, 77-76, on a layup from junior guard Tony Lee with 3:36 to go. Harris tied the game at 77-77 by hitting one of two free throws after a foul by senior center Freddie Harris, and his free throw with 42 seconds to play gave the Knights the lead for good, 78-77. Jackson missed a jumper in the paint with 27 seconds remaining, and Ubilla hit both of his free throws to push FDU to an 80-77 advantage. Chappell led Robert Morris with 23 points on 9-of-13 shooting, while Jackson added 18 and Coleman 14 points.

Fairleigh Dickinson Game Notes - After starting the year 7-0 at home Robert Morris has now dropped two of its last three at the Charles L. Sewall Center after its loss to the Knights ... RMU was a perfect 11-for-11 from the free-throw line, marking a season high and the best since the club finished 15-for-15 in a 63-62 win over St. Francis (N.Y.) (1/6/05) ... The Colonials finished with 18 turnovers and have committed 38 in their two-game slide ... Junior guard Tony Lee had his double figure scoring streak snapped at four by finishing with nine points and hit on just four of his nine shots from the field ... Both clubs hit shot 47.1 percent from beyond the arc as each drained eight of 17 attempts ... Robert Morris finished with 10 steals as senior forward A.J. Jackson tied a career high with three thefts ... The Colonials shot 50.8 percent (30-for-59) from the field, the fourth time in the last five games the club has shot 50 percent or better from the floor.

Putting It All Together - Despite an up and down season offensively, sophomore guard Jeremy Chappell seems to be saving his best for the home stretch of the 2006-07 campaign. Over the last four games Chappell has posted solid numbers across the board, scoring at an 18.8 points per game clip while adding averages of 4.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.8 steals per contest. More importantly, Chappell seems to be finding his shooting touch. Over that same time span Chappell has converted 57.7 percent (30-for-52) of his shots from the floor. A key reason Chappell has found the touch is due to three-point shooting. Since going 0-for-6 from long range against Sacred Heart (1/18/07), Chappell has hit on 11 of his 20 opportunities (55 percent) in the last four games.

Offensively Speaking - Robert Morris enters Saturday's game against Saint Francis (Pa.) having seemingly hit its stride offensively, as the club has shot a solid 50.1 percent (340-for-678) from the field in its last 12 games. Over that span the Colonials have shot 50 percent or better from the field seven times. Due to the surge, RMU owns a team shooting percentage of 47.3 percent (548-for-1,159) on the season, which leads the Northeast Conference. The Colonials have never lead the league in field goal percentage in 26 years as part of the conference.

Defensively Speaking - Looking for a reason Robert Morris owns a record of 2-3 in its last five games? Look no further than the defensive end. In the last five contests, opponents have converted 55.7 percent (147-for-264) of its field goals, including a mark of 46.7 percent (43-for-92) from beyond the arc. In each of those games opponents have shot 50 percent or better from the field, marking the longest streak of such games under sixth-year head coach Mark Schmidt. It could also be construed as the worst stretch of defense for the Colonials in school history. On record, RMU's five straight games allowing an opponent to shoot 50 percent or better from the field is the worst since the 1995-96 campaign. In home losses to St. Francis (N.Y.), Long Island, Marist and Fairleigh Dickinson from Jan. 25, 1996, to Feb. 5, 1996, a stretch of four games, Robert Morris allowed its foes to shoot 50.9 percent (111-for-218) from the floor.

Balance Beam - In the first 11 games of the 2006-07 Northeast Conference schedule for Robert Morris this season, the Colonials have received about as balanced scoring as you could possibly witness. A total of 19 points separates RMU's leading scorer in league games to its fourth highest scorer. Senior forward A.J. Jackson (177 points) leads the club in scoring in NEC tilts at 16.1 points per game, while senior guard Derek Coleman ranks fourth (14.4 ppg) with 158 points.

The Patriot - Any success Robert Morris will have in the second half of its 2006-07 Northeast Conference season will depend in large part to the play of senior guard Derek Coleman. A natural playmaker, the Boston, Mass., product has also increased his offensive production since the calendar has switched to the year 2007. In nine games since returning to league play, Coleman is averaging 15.1 points per contest while shooting 51.1 percent (46-for-90) from the floor. Even with the increased offensive output, it hasn't slowed Coleman down in creating opportunities for his teammates. In the same stretch Coleman is averaging 6.1 assists per game, a big reason he leads the circuit in NEC games in the category (6.27 apg).

Both Ends of the Floor - Junior guard Tony Lee has been the most complete player for Robert Morris in 2006-07, and the evidence is in the numbers. Offensively, Lee ranks second for Robert Morris in scoring (15.1 ppg) while pacing the Northeast Conference in field goal percentage (.606). Defensively, Lee also leads the circuit in steals by averaging 2.80 per game. In the national rankings through games of Jan. 28, 2007, Lee ranks ninth in Division I in steals, while his field goal percentage ranks 18th. He is the only player from an NEC school to rank in the 20 top in two categories. A look at the numbers ...

Triple Threat - With junior guard Tony Lee leading the Northeast Conference in field goal percentage (60.6 percent) while ranking fifth in assists (4.3 per game), it has him approaching a milestone few have accomplished in the history of the league. With career totals of 882 points, 484 rebounds and 232 assists, Lee has an outside shot this season of becoming just the fifth player in league history to eclipse career totals of 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 250 assists. The last player to turn the trick was Kason Mims of Quinnipiac, who finished his career with 1,335 points, 548 caroms and 453 assists. If Lee were to eclipse those totals this season, he would be the first of the five to accomplish the feat as a junior.

Combination Platter - So far this season, Robert Morris has received 77.3 percent of its offense from its usual contributors in guards Derek Coleman, Tony Lee and Jeremy Chappell and forward A.J. Jackson. Despite that, dating back to the start of the 2005-06 campaign, when Coleman and Jackson combine to score more than 30 points in a game, the Colonials own a record of 16-5 (.762). Included in that is a mark of 7-2 so far this season.

Mr. Perfect - Junior guard Tony Lee certainly could be looked at as RMU's most valuable player as the club is off to a 13-7 start to the 2006-07 season, and he probably was never more valuable in a game than in an 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/06). Lee finished a perfect 8-for-8 from the field, including 1for-1 from beyond the arc, in scoring 17 points while adding a team high seven rebounds, four assists and two steals. The only other perfect day for a Robert Morris player on record with more than five field goal attempts was former Colonial Bubba Donnelly (1991-95), who finished 7-for-7 from the field for 21 points in an 80-59 win @ Rider (1/10/94). All seven of Donnelly's field goals in that game were three-pointers.

The Encore - While junior guard Tony Lee nailed all eight of his shots from the field in RMU's 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/06), freshman guard Jimmy Langhurst provided the encore in an 83-38 win over Division III Goucher (12/30/06). Langhurst hit all four of his shots from the field, including two from long range, and sank all four of his free-throw opportunities in producing a career high 14 points and finishing second on the club in scoring against the Gophers. Possibly the purest shooter on the club, Langhurst has hit on 60 percent (6-of-10) of his shots this season, including three of his five opportunities from downtown.

Straight Shooter - Junior guard Tony Lee hit his first six shots from the field in RMU's 83-38 win over Goucher (12/30/06) before missing a three-pointer with a minute to go in the first half. With that missed trifecta it ended a streak of 16 straight field goals for Lee dating back to the club's 79-78 win over Youngstown State (12/16/06). Lee hit his last two field goals against the Penguins, all eight of his shots in an 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/06) before hitting his first six shots from the floor against the Gophers.

Hard to Imagine - A very important part to senior guard Derek Coleman's offensive output over his four-year career has been the ability to knock down the three-point shot. Coleman owns 185 three-pointers on his career, which ranks fifth all-time at Robert Morris. However, in RMU's 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/04), Coleman finished with 14 points despite not hitting a three-pointer. He finished 4-for-10 from the field and a perfect 6-for-6 from the freethrow line for his 14 points but was 0-for-4 from beyond the arc. It marks the first time in his career Coleman, with 46 career double-figure scoring games to his credit, finished in double digits without hitting a three-pointer.

The Strokes - Thanks to a perfect performance of 3-for-3 from the free-throw line against Fairleigh Dickinson (2/1/07), senior guard Derek Coleman enters Saturday's game against Saint Francis (Pa.) having connected on each of his last 13 attempts from the charity stripe in the last four games. It marks his second double-digit streak of the 2006-07 campaign, as Coleman hit 17 straight over a seven-game span in December and January. The surge has pushed Coleman's free-throw shooting percentage to 88.2 percent (45-for-51) on the season, which ranks second in the Northeast Conference. Coleman could possibly be making runs at both the single-season and career records for free throw shooting. The single-season mark is held by former Colonial Brandon Welsch, who converted 87.7 percent (71-for-81) of his shots in 1998-99. The career record of 86 percent is held by former Colonial Tom Parks (1978-83). Coleman enters Saturday's game against Saint Francis (Pa.) with a career free-throw shooting percentage of 83 percent (166-for-200), which ranks third in the career annals at Robert Morris.

Select Company - Senior forward A.J. Jackson, a 2006-07 preseason All-Northeast Conference Team selection, put together one of his best games in a Colonial uniform in RMU's 73-69 win @ Marshall (11/17/06). Jackson finished with 30 points on 9-of-18 shooting and also compiled 15 rebounds, including six offensive boards, for his 15th career double-double. His 30-point effort marks the second time Jackson has hit the 30-point plateau in a contest, while his 15 rebounds marks the third time he has recorded at least 15 caroms in a game. A quick glance at the Robert Morris single-game records, and Jackson has an opportunity to post the most 30point scoring games in school history and is already tied for the most games with 15+ rebounds. Former Colonial Myron Walker (1991-94) posted six games in which he scored 30 or more points, while former Colonials Earl Cureton (1976-77) and Anthony Dickens (1985-90) own three games of posting at least 15 rebounds in a game. Clutch Shooting - A number of Colonials have begun to show their penchant for clutch shooting late in ball games as Robert Morris enters the second half of the 2006-07 campaign. In a 73-69 victory @ Marshall (11/17/06) in the club's first road game of the season, senior forward A.J. Jackson and senior guard Derek Coleman each hit three-pointers in the last 1:35 of the contest to help propel the Colonials to victory. Coleman's three-pointer with 49 seconds to go gave Robert Morris the lead for good, and it marks his second career three-pointer in the last minute of a game that gave the Colonials a lead. Coleman drained a three-pointer with 12 seconds to play to lift RMU to a 69-68 victory @ Central Connecticut State (2/14/04) during his freshman campaign. Sophomore guard Jeremy Chappell, meanwhile, sunk a three-pointer with 12.3 seconds remaining to lift Robert Morris to a 67-66 win @ Mount St. Mary's (3/3/06) in the 2006 NEC Tournament quarterfinals.

RMU Weekly Honors - Senior forward A.J. Jackson (Northeast Conference Choice Hotels Player of the Week - 11/20/06) ... Senior forward A.J. Jackson (NEC Choice Hotels Player of the Week - 11/27/06) ... Junior guard Tony Lee (NEC Choice Hotels Player of the Week - 12/18/06) ... Junior guard Tony Lee (NEC Choice Hotels Player of the Week - 1/2/07).

Running With the Devil - Robert Morris has played some close ball games so far on the 2006-07 season, with the Colonials coming out on top. In games decided by five points or less RMU boasts a record of 6-3, including a pair of one-point victories. That mark has helped Robert Morris improve to 27-21 (.563) under sixth-year head coach Mark Schmidt in games decided by five points or less. However, basketball is a game of runs, and that has never been more prudent than with Robert Morris in 2006-07. In 18 of RMU's 20 games so far this season, the Colonials have either owned a double-digit lead or trailed by double digits.

Iron Man - Senior guard Derek Coleman doesn't get comfortable sitting on the bench during games. In fact, he rarely is off the court at all. Coleman enters Thursday's game @ Fairleigh Dickinson having played a full contest in nine of the club's 20 games this season, and in two other contests he has logged 39 minutes. It's a trend that hasn't subsided for RMU's floor general since he became a regular starter for the club at the end of his freshman season. Coleman has played a full game's worth of action a total of 32 times in his Robert Morris career, including a pair of 45-minute stints thanks to overtime games. Since earning his first start against Sacred Heart back on Feb. 5, 2004, Coleman has averaged 35.4 minutes per game in 88 starts.

Making It Count - An area of strength for RMU under the direction of head coach Mark Schmidt has been the ability of the team to convert at the free-throw line. Robert Morris has finished in the top five in the Northeast Conference in free-throw percentage each of the previous five years, including a league-best 75.4 percent (384-for-576) in 2003-04. So far this season the Colonials rank second in the circuit in free throw percentage, converting 74.2 percent (241-for-325) of their opportunities. Robert Morris has been even better in pressure situations, converting a solid 81.1 percent (73-for-90) of its shots in the last five minutes and overtime of games. Senior guard Derek Coleman and senior forward A.J. Jackson have been at the stripe the most in crunch time, combining to hit 32 of their 37 opportunities (86.5 percent).

Pop Goes the Weasel - Junior guard Tony Lee was all over the court in RMU's 73-72 win over Duquesne (12/2/06), especially on defense. Lee broke a 19-year old Charles L. Sewall Center record for steals by registering eight against the Dukes, including three in the last 12:07 as RMU climbed out of a 10-point deficit. Lee's eight steals eclipsed the old record of seven, which was originally established by Drafton Davis of Marist. Davis recorded his seven thefts in a 61-57 overtime victory over the Colonials Feb. 28, 1987. Lee's eight steals is the sixth highest single-game total of the 2006-07 season in Division I, behind Travis Holmes of VMI (11 steals), Ledell Eackles of Campbell (10 steals) and Darren Collison of UCLA, Damian Martin of Loyola Marymount and Chavis Holmes of VMI, who each have posted nine steals.

Creating & Creating - Senior guard Derek Coleman has done a solid job this year doing what he does best: creating opportunities for his teammates. Coleman dished out seven assists against Fairleigh Dickinson (2/1/07) to push his career total to 398, which ranks sixth all-time at Robert Morris. He is just two assists shy of becoming just the fourth Colonial in school history with 400 career dimes and the first since Javier Smith finished with 459 from 1994-98. Coleman currently is tops in the Northeast Conference in assists per game (5.50) after leading the circuit in 2005-06 with an average of 4.72 per game.

Spread The Jam - One of the strength's for Robert Morris on the 2006-07 campaign has been the club's ability to be unselfish, and it's a trend that has continued as the Colonials have returned to league play. In the last 12 contests RMU has converted a total of 340 field goals, with the club posting assists on 199 of those baskets. That equates to almost 60 percent (58.5) of the club's field goals. As a club so far this year Robert Morris is averaging 16.20 assists per game, which leads the Northeast Conference. The highest assist per game average by RMU in the six-year tenure of head coach Mark Schmidt is 15.2 dimes per contest, set in Schmidt's inaugural season as head coach in 2001-02.

Daytona 500 - While junior guard Tony Lee has an outside shot of joining the 1,000-point club this season, barring injury he should almost assuredly eclipse the 500-rebound plateau. Lee enters Saturday's game with 484 career caroms, which ranks 18th all-time at Robert Morris. At his current pace (6.4 rpg), Lee is on pace to push his career total for rebounds to 529 by the end of the 2006-07 regular season, at total that would rank 10th all-time. There are currently 12 members in the 500-rebound club at Robert Morris.

The Chase Is On - For the second time in three seasons, the Robert Morris career record for three-point field goals could be challenged in 2006-07. Former Colonial Aaron Thomas (2000-04) established a new career record for three-pointers in 2003-04 by finishing his career with 218. That record was only 48 treys ahead of former Colonial Maurice Carter (2001-05) entering the 2004-05 campaign, but Carter hit just 47 in his senior season to finish second in the record books with 217 career three-pointers. Now, thanks to a career high 74 three-pointers in 2005-06, senior Derek Coleman entered his final season in 2006-07 a total of 78 three-pointers shy of breaking the record held by Thomas. Coleman owns 44 three-pointers so far on the 2006-07 season, pushing his career total to 185, which ranks fifth all-time at RMU. With seven regular-season games remaining in 2006-07, Coleman needs 34 three-pointers to eclipse the record of 218 held by Thomas. Over that span Coleman will need to average 4.9 three-pointers per game.

Home Is Where the Heart Is - Senior forward A.J. Jackson has found the Charles L. Sewall Center to his liking. Dating back to the start of the 2005-06 campaign, Jackson has been as solid a player as any for the Colonials at home, averaging 18.6 points and 9.1 rebounds in 23 career games at the Sewall Center. Jackson became just the second Colonial in school history to average over 20 points per game at home last season when he scored at a 20.8 points per game clip. The only other Colonial to average over 20 points per contest in a season in the Sewall Center's 22-year history was RMU all-time leading scorer Myron Walker (1990-94), who averaged 21.1 points per game as a sophomore in 1991-92. Jackson also has an opportunity to post the best career scoring average by a Colonial at the Sewall Center. That mark is also held by Walker at 18.5 points per game. Jackson**, junior guard **Tony Lee** and sophomore guard **Jeremy Chappell**. While Chappell is well on his way to becoming a 1,000-point scorer at RMU after a freshman campaign in which he was named the 2006 NEC Rookie of the Year, Coleman, Jackson and Lee each entered this season with outside shots of joining RMU's 1,000-point club. The top mark by an NEC returning scoring duo was McCrommon and Carter, who averaged 35.5 points game entering 2003-04.

Home Sweet Home - Robert Morris has learned to protect its home court at the Charles L. Sewall Center, as the Colonials notched a 96-72 win in its 2006-07 season opener over Florida International at home, a year after posting an 11-2 record at home. Thanks to an 8-2 record at the Sewall Center so far this season, RMU has posted a record of 49-25 (.662) at the home under sixth-year head coach Mark Schmidt. Overall in the 22-year history of the facility the Colonials have posted a record of 172-106 (.619).

Four on the Floor - Senior forward A.J. Jackson had his streak of 20+ point scoring games snapped at four when he finished with just eight points @ Monmouth (1/27/07). Despite that, it marked Jackson's second such streak of the 2006-07 season. In RMU's 4-0 start to the year, Jackson averaged 24.0 points per game and eclipsed the 20-point plateau in each contest. He became the first Colonial in school history to post a pair of streaks of at least four games scoring 20+ points in the same season and just the second player to turn the trick overall. Former Colonial Gene Nabors (1995-2000) also accomplished the feat twice, turning the trick in each of the 1998-99 and 1999-2000 campaigns. Jackson is also just the fifth player in school history to score at least 20 points in four straight games overall, as joining him and Nabors are former Colonials Myron Walker (1990-94), Keith Jones (1995-99) and Wesley Fluellen (1997-2002). Nabors is also the only Colonial in school history to have more than four games of scoring 20+ points in a contest, as he averaged 27.1 points over eight straight games late in the 1999-2000 season. Streakers - By finishing with eight points in a 59-56 setback @ Long Island, junior guard Tony Lee had his double-figure scoring streak snapped at 11 games. The streak was tied for the third longest by a Colonial on the active roster, and it also tied Lee's career-best streak. He scored in double figures in 11 straight contests from Jan. 26, 2006 to March 2, 2006. Sophomore guard Jeremy Chappell currently owns the longest double-figure scoring streak, which is four games.

2006 Northeast Conference Preseason Coaches Poll

According to a poll of league head coaches, Robert Morris was been picked to finish second in the Northeast Conference in 2006-07. It marks the highest preseason ranking for the Colonials ever, matching their second-place preseason prediction prior to the 1991-92 campaign. RMU received five firstplace votes, with the other six going to Monmouth, which was tabbed as the preseason favorite.

Following Monmouth and Robert Morris in the top five in the poll are Long Island, Central Connecticut State and Quinnipiac. The Blue Devils and Bobcats were picked to tie for fourth in the poll. Rounding out the annual poll is Wagner, Fairleigh Dickinson, St. Francis (N.Y.), Sacred Heart, Mount St. Mary's and Saint Francis (Pa.).

As well as being picked second in the preseason poll, Robert Morris placed senior forward A.J. Jackson on the 2006-07 NEC preseason all-conference team. Joining Jackson are forwards Margues Alston of Monmouth and Obie Nwadike of Central Connecticut State and guards Jarrid Frye of Sacred Heart and James Williams of Long Island.

Conducted annually, NEC coaches have failed to correctly forecast the eventual league champion since selecting Mount St. Mary's to win it all in 1998-99, and have proven inaccurate in 17 of the last 19 years.

This year marks the eighth time that Monmouth has been selected the Northeast Conference's preseason favorite by league head coaches, the most in conference history by a wide margin.

The Need for Three

The Colonials have relied heavily on the three-point shot under the direction of Mark Schmidt during his six years as head coach, with evidence the club's three-point field goal totals. In 2005-06 RMU shattered the team record for three-pointers with 260, eclipsing the club's old mark of 213, which was set in 2003-04. On the 2005-06 campaign, RMU averaged 8.97 three-pointers a game to lead the Northeast Conference. Since the start of the 2001-02 season, the Colonials lead the NEC in three-pointers made per game (7.48), ahead of St. Francis (N.Y.), which has averaged 7.09 three-pointers a contest.
