**Top Story** - The Robert Morris University men's basketball team gets back to action Saturday night after a week off when it travels to Emmitsburg, Md., for a 7:00 p.m. Northeast Conference game against Mount St. Mary's at Knott Arena. The Colonials are coming off a 76-68 victory over in-state rival Saint Francis (Pa.) (2/3/07) to snap a two-game slide and will look to clinch the program's second straight winning season with a victory over the Mount. RMU currently stands in a tie for sixth place in the NEC standings with its 6-6 league record and is two and-a-half games out of second place, which is currently occupied by Quinnipiac (9-4 NEC record). In all, just two and-a-half games separates second place from eighth place in the league standings.

**Quick Stat of the Night** - Robert Morris is coming off a 76-68 victory over Saint Francis (Pa.) (2/3/07) in which the club converted a season high 26 free throws, finishing the game 26-for-29 from the charity stripe, a success rate of 89.7 percent. The Colonials have been the hottest team in the Northeast Conference from the free-throw line in recent weeks, as the club has shot a blistering 84.2 percent (96-for-114) in the last seven games, shooting better than 80 percent in six of those contests. The surge has boosted RMU to the top of the league in free-throw shooting, as the club's season shooting percentage of 75.4 percent (267-for-354) is ahead of Saint Francis (Pa.) (74.0 percent).

**Saturday's Opponent and the All-Time Series** - Mount St. Mary's and Robert Morris will square off for the 39th time Saturday night, with the Mount holding a 22-16 edge in the all-time series. There might not be a closer rivalry in the Northeast Conference over the course of the last two seasons, as the four meetings between the two clubs since the start of the 2005-06 campaign have been decided by a total of seven points. The Colonials took the first game of the 2006-07 season series thanks to an 81-78 overtime win at the Charles L. Sewall Center (1/20/07). In that game senior forward **A.J. Jackson** paced RMU with 20 points.

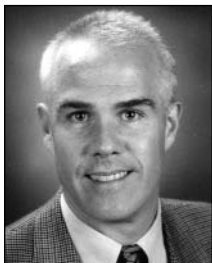

## Head Coach Mark Schmidt Sixth Season - Boston College '85



The 2006-07 campaign marks **Mark Schmidt's** sixth year as head coach of the men's basketball program at Robert Morris University. He owns an overall record of 79-86 (.479), including a 55-49 (.529) mark in the Northeast Conference, and was named to his current post May 7, 2001. Schmidt guided the Colonials to their first winning season in six years in 2005-06 with an overall record of 15-14, including 10-8 in conference action. He also led RMU to the NEC Tournament semifinals for the second time in the last three years in 2006. In 2003-04 and 2004-05, he led RMU to identical overall

records of 14-15. In 2001-02, Schmidt led Robert Morris to a 12-18 overall record, the most victories for a first-year head coach in the 30-year history of the Colonial men's basketball program.

Prior to RMU, Schmidt spent seven seasons as one of the nation's top assistants at Xavier University under current Wake Forest head coach Skip Prosser from 1994-2001. While with the Musketeers, Schmidt played a dual role, serving as both a coach and the program's top recruiter. His coaching responsibilities centered mostly around the post players, and he helped develop and recruit players at Xavier that have moved on to the professional ranks, including James Posey (Miami Heat), David West (New Orleans Hornets), Romain Sato (San Antonio Spurs), Lionel Chalmers (Minnesota Timberwolves) and David Young (Seattle Supersonics). Prior to his stint with Xavier, Schmidt served one year as an assistant at Loyola College in Baltimore, Md., also under Prosser. He also spent two seasons at Penn State University under Bruce Parkhill from 1991-93, and started his coaching career as an assistant at St. Michael's College in Vermont from 1989-91.

Schmidt's playing career was highlighted by four years as a guard/forward at Boston College, where he received his bachelor's degree in business administration and management with a concentration in marketing in 1985. The Eagles went 22-10 and made the NCAA Elite Eight during his freshman season in 1981-82 under head coach Tom Davis and 25-7 the next year in making the NCAA Tournament Sweet Sixteen in his first of three years playing for current Maryland coach Gary Williams. Boston College reached the NIT second round in 1984 and the NCAA Sweet Sixteen again in 1985.

**Scouting the Mount** - Mount St. Mary's enters Saturday's game with an overall record of 9-15, including 8-5 in Northeast Conference action, and occupies fourth place in the league standings. The Mount has been led by junior guard Chris Vann, who averages 13.2 points per game and owns a team-high 50 three-pointers. However, in the first meeting with RMU on Jan. 20, 2007, Vann was held to just three points. The leading rebounder for Mount St. Mary's has been senior guard Mychal Kearsse, who pulls down an average of 5.6 per game. Kearsse finished with 21 points on 10-of-12 shooting from the floor against Robert Morris in the first meeting this season.

**Mount St. Mary's Head Coach** - The 2006-07 campaign is the fourth season for head coach **Milan Brown (Howard '93)** on the sidelines at Mount St. Mary's. He enters Saturday's game with an overall record of 39-71 (.355), including a mark of 32-35 (.478) in the NEC.

**RMU's Last Game** - Senior forward **A.J. Jackson** notched his fifth double-double of the season to lead Robert Morris to a 76-68 win over in-state rival Saint Francis (Pa.) Feb. 3. Robert Morris raced to a 25-9 lead in the first 10 minutes as Jackson and junior guard **Tony Lee** each scored nine points to pace the surge. The lead remained in double digits for RMU until Marquis Ford hit a three-pointer with 6:41 to play before the break to close the Red Flash within nine, 28-19. However, the Colonials visited the free-throw line 17 times in the first half, connecting on 16 of those opportunities, to help keep their lead in double digits. Saint Francis (Pa.) was able to close to within seven at the break, 39-32, when J.R. Enright hit a three-pointer with five seconds to go before halftime. The Red Flash carried that momentum over to the second half, scoring the first seven points of the stanza to knot the score at 39-39. Cale Nelson hit a three-pointer, while Ford tied it with a layup after a steal. Lee came back to push Robert Morris back on top, 42-39, with a three-pointer, but Enright answered Lee's trifecta with one of his own to tie the score again, 42-42. The second half featured eight ties, and the Red Flash logged their first lead of the contest with 5:08 to play, 60-58, when Enright scored a layup to cap a 13-7 SFU run. Lee came back to give Robert Morris the lead for good when he scored on a layup with 4:22 to play and was fouled in the act by Ford. Lee converted the three-point play to push the Colonials in front, 61-60, which started RMU on a 12-2 spurt to help seal the victory. Sophomore guard **Jeremy Chappell** hit a three-pointer during the run to give the Colonials a 64-60 edge, while senior guard **Derek Coleman's** fastbreak layup with 2:03 remaining after a steal by Lee pushed RMU up to an eight-point lead, 70-62. Jackson finished 7-for-9 from the field and 7-for-8 from the free-throw line for his 22 points and added 10 rebounds, all defensive. Chappell finished with 20 points, seven rebounds, five assists and four steals, while Lee contributed 19 points and five thefts. Enright led Saint Francis (Pa.) with a career high 22 points on 9-of-15 shooting, including 3-for-5 from beyond the arc, while Ford finished with 14 points, four assists and three steals.

**Saint Francis (Pa.) Game Notes** - Robert Morris held Saint Francis (Pa.) to a shooting percentage of 44.4 percent (24-for-54), the first time in seven games the Colonials have held an opponent to shooting percentage of under 50 percent ... RMU hit just four of its 15 three-point field goals (26.7 percent) as senior guard **Derek Coleman** was 0-for-5 from beyond the arc ... Coleman finished with eight points but added six assists and two steals in a full 40 minutes ... It marked the 10th time this season Coleman has played a full game's worth of action and sixth time in 12 Northeast Conference contests ... The Red Flash won the battle of the boards, 32-28, and held a 14-8 edge on the offensive glass ... Robert Morris finished with 12 steals, the sixth time this season the club has finished with at least 10 steals, and enters Saturday's game @ Mount St. Mary's averaging 9.4 thefts in its last five games.

**Free Samples** - The fact that Robert Morris has shot 84.2 percent (96-for-114) from the free-throw line in the last seven games has been a testament to a number of Colonials concentrating at the charity stripe. A look at some streaks entering Saturday's game @ Mount St. Mary's ... Over the last seven games senior forward **A.J. Jackson** has shot 88.5 percent (23-for-26) from the charity stripe ... Junior guard **Tony Lee**, who after hitting just 37 of his first 64 attempts (57.8 percent) of his shots from the free-throw line this season, has shot 84.6 percent (22-for-26) from the free-throw line in the same seven-game span ... Sophomore guard **Jeremy Chappell** has converted 17 of his 18 opportunities (94.4 percent) in NEC games ... In the last five games senior guard **Derek Coleman** has shot 92.9 percent (13-for-14) from the free-throw line.

**The Road Less Traveled** - Robert Morris travels to Emmitsburg, Md., Saturday for its contest against Mount St. Mary's having actually shot better from beyond the arc in Northeast Conference road games compared to at home in the Charles L. Sewall Center. Since finishing a season low 2-for-22 (9.1 percent) from long range @ Sacred Heart (12/7/06), the Colonials have averaged 8.8 three-pointers in their last five NEC road contests and have shot an even 40 percent (44-for-110) from beyond the three-point line. RMU has been remarkably consistent in its three-point shooting regardless of playing at home or on the road this season, averaging 7.1 three-pointers at the Sewall Center compared to 7.3 three-pointers on the road.

**Putting It All Together** - Despite an up and down season offensively, sophomore guard **Jeremy Chappell** seems to be saving his best for the home stretch of the 2006-07 campaign. Over the last five games Chappell has posted solid numbers across the board, scoring at a 19.0 points per game clip while adding averages of 4.6 rebounds, 3.8 assists and 3.0 steals per contest. More importantly, Chappell seems to be finding his shooting touch. Over that same time span Chappell has converted 58.1 percent (36-for-62) of his shots from the floor. A key reason Chappell has found the touch is due to three-point shooting. Since going 0-for-6 from long range against Sacred Heart (1/18/07), Chappell has hit on 13 of his 24 opportunities (54.2 percent) in the last five games.

**Offensively Speaking** - Robert Morris enters Saturday's game @ Mount St. Mary's having seemingly hit its stride offensively, as the club has shot a solid 50.1 percent (363-for-724) from the field in its last 13 games. Over that span the Colonials have shot 50 percent or better from the field eight times. Due to the surge, RMU owns a team shooting percentage of 47.4 percent (571-for-1,205) on the season, which leads the Northeast Conference. The Colonials have never lead the league in field goal percentage in 26 years as part of the conference.

**Coleman's Court** - Senior guard **Derek Coleman** enters Saturday's game leading the Northeast Conference in assists with an average of 5.52 per game, a total that also ranks 30th in Division I. He's trying to become just the third player in league history to lead the circuit in assists in back-to-back years and first since Rahsaan Johnson in 2000-01 (5.7 apg) and 2001-02 (5.3 apg). Former St. Francis (N.Y.) guard Greg Nunn posted averages of 5.6 and 6.1 assists per game, respectively, in 1998-99 and 1999-2000. Coleman led the NEC last year in assists per game (4.7).

**Both Ends of the Floor** - Junior guard **Tony Lee** has been the most complete player for Robert Morris in 2006-07, and the evidence is in the numbers. Offensively, Lee ranks second for Robert Morris in scoring (15.2 ppg) while pacing the Northeast Conference in field goal percentage (.597). Defensively, Lee also leads the circuit in steals by averaging 2.90 per game. In the national rankings through games of Feb. 4, 2007, Lee ranks fifth in Division I in steals, while his field goal percentage ranks 26th. He is the only player from an NEC school to rank in the 30 top in two categories. A look at the numbers ...

**Triple Threat** - With junior guard **Tony Lee** leading the Northeast Conference in field goal percentage (59.7 percent) while ranking sixth in assists (4.12 per game), it has him approaching a milestone few have accomplished in the history of the league. With career totals of 901 points, 486 rebounds and 235 assists, Lee has an outside shot this season of becoming just the fifth player in league history to eclipse career totals of 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 250 assists. The last player to turn the trick was Kason Mims of Quinnipiac, who finished his career with 1,335 points, 548 caroms and 453 assists. If Lee were to eclipse those totals this season, he would be the first of the five to accomplish the feat as a junior.

**Combination Platter** - So far this season, Robert Morris has received 77.9 percent of its offense from its usual contributors in guards **Derek Coleman**, **Tony Lee** and **Jeremy Chappell** and forward **A.J. Jackson**. Despite that, dating back to the start of the 2005-06 campaign, when Coleman and Jackson combine to score more than 30 points in a game, the Colonials own a record of **17-5 (.773)**. Included in that is a mark of **8-2** so far this season.

**Zoom Zoom Zoom** - Junior guard **Tony Lee**, with 486 career rebounds to his credit entering Saturday's game @ Mount St. Mary's, has an opportunity to become the fastest Colonial to the 500-rebound mark in school history. Lee has accumulated his 486 rebounds in 78 career games, which equates to an average of 6.2 caroms per contest. RMU's all-time leading rebounder, Anthony Dickens (1985-90), grabbed his 500th rebound in his 81st career game. He finished with eight in a 70-59 victory @ Niagara (11/29/89) to eclipse the 500-rebound plateau, the fastest Colonial to go over the mark. Lee is just 14 rebounds shy of 500 for his career and will appear in his 79th career game Saturday @ the Mount.

**Mr. Perfect** - Junior guard **Tony Lee** certainly could be looked at as RMU's most valuable player as the club is off to a 14-7 start to the 2006-07 season, and he probably was never more valuable in a game than in an 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/06). Lee finished a perfect 8-for-8 from the field, including 1-for-1 from beyond the arc, in scoring 17 points while adding a team high seven rebounds, four assists and two steals. The only other perfect day for a Robert Morris player on record with more than five field goal attempts was former Colonial Bubba Donnelly (1991-95), who finished 7-for-7 from the field for 21 points in an 80-59 win @ Rider (1/10/94). All seven of Donnelly's field goals in that game were three-pointers.

**Straight Shooter** - Junior guard **Tony Lee** hit his first six shots from the field in RMU's 83-38 win over Goucher (12/30/06) before missing a three-pointer with a minute to go in the first half. With that missed trifecta it ended a streak of 16 straight field goals for Lee dating back to the club's 79-78 win over Youngstown State (12/16/06). Lee hit his last two field goals against the Penguins, all eight of his shots in an 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/06) before hitting his first six shots from the floor against the Gophers.

**Hard to Imagine** - A very important part to senior guard **Derek Coleman's** offensive output over his four-year career has been the ability to knock down the three-point shot. Coleman owns 185 three-pointers on his career, which ranks fifth all-time at Robert Morris. However, in RMU's 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/04), Coleman finished with 14 points despite not hitting a three-pointer. He finished 4-for-10 from the field and a perfect 6-for-6 from the free-throw line for his 14 points but was 0-for-4 from beyond the arc. It marks the first time in his career Coleman, with 46 career double-figure scoring games to his credit, finished in double digits without hitting a three-pointer.

**The Strokes** - Despite having his consecutive streak of free throws snapped at 13 in a 76-68 win over Saint Francis (Pa.) (2/3/07), senior guard **Derek Coleman** still has shot **92.9 percent (13-for-14)** from the free-throw line in his last five games. Coleman's run marked his second double-digit streak of the 2006-07 campaign, as he hit 17 straight over a seven-game span in December and January. Coleman currently ranks second in the Northeast Conference with a free-throw percentage of **87 percent (47-for-54)** and could possibly be making runs at both the single-season and career records for free throw shooting. The single-season mark is held by former Colonial Brandon Welsch, who converted 87.7 percent (71-for-81) of his shots in 1998-99. The career record of 86 percent is held by former Colonial Tom Parks (1978-83). Coleman enters Saturday's game @ Mount St. Mary's with a career free-throw shooting percentage of 82.8 percent (168-for-203), which ranks third in the career record book at Robert Morris.

**Select Company** - Senior forward **A.J. Jackson**, a 2006-07 preseason All-Northeast Conference Team selection, put together one of his best games in a Colonial uniform in RMU's 73-69 win @ Marshall (11/17/06). Jackson finished with 30 points on 9-of-18 shooting and also compiled 15 rebounds, including six offensive boards, for his 15th career double-double. His 30-point effort marks the second time Jackson has hit the 30-point plateau in a contest, while his 15 rebounds marks the third time he has recorded at least 15 caroms in a game. A quick glance at the Robert Morris single-game records, and Jackson has an opportunity to post the most 30-point scoring games in school history and is already tied for the most games with 15+ rebounds. Former Colonial Myron Walker (1991-94) posted six games in which he scored 30 or more points, while former Colonials Earl Cureton (1976-77) and Anthony Dickens (1985-90) own three games of posting at least 15 rebounds in a game. **Clutch Shooting** - A number of Colonials have begun to show their penchant for clutch shooting late in ball games as Robert Morris enters the second half of the 2006-07 campaign. In a 73-69 victory @ Marshall (11/17/06) in the club's first road game of the season, senior forward **A.J. Jackson** and senior guard **Derek Coleman** each hit three-pointers in the last 1:35 of the contest to help propel the Colonials to victory. Coleman's three-pointer with 49 seconds to go gave Robert Morris the lead for good, and it marks his second career three-pointer in the last minute of a game that gave the Colonials a lead. Coleman drained a three-pointer with 12 seconds to play to lift RMU to a 69-68 victory @ Central Connecticut State (2/14/04) during his freshman campaign. Sophomore guard **Jeremy Chappell**, meanwhile, sunk a three-pointer with 12.3 seconds remaining to lift Robert Morris to a 67-66 win @ Mount St. Mary's (3/3/06) in the 2006 NEC Tournament quarterfinals.

**RMU Weekly Honors** - Senior forward **A.J. Jackson** (Northeast Conference *Choice Hotels* Player of the Week - 11/20/06) ... Senior forward **A.J. Jackson** (NEC *Choice Hotels* Player of the Week - 11/27/06) ... Junior guard **Tony Lee** (NEC *Choice Hotels* Player of the Week - 12/18/06) ... Junior guard **Tony Lee** (NEC *Choice Hotels* Player of the Week - 1/2/07).

**Running With the Devil** - Robert Morris has played some close ball games so far on the 2006-07 season, with the Colonials coming out on top. In games decided by five points or less RMU boasts a record of 6-3, including a pair of one-point victories. That mark has helped Robert Morris improve to 27-21 (.563) under sixth-year head coach **Mark Schmidt** in games decided by five points or less. However, basketball is a game of runs, and that has never been more prudent than with Robert Morris in 2006-07. In 19 of RMU's 21 games so far this season, the Colonials have either owned a double-digit lead or trailed by double digits.

**Iron Man** - Senior guard **Derek Coleman** doesn't get comfortable sitting on the bench during games. In fact, he rarely is off the court at all. Coleman enters Saturday's game @ Mount St. Mary's having played a full contest in 10 of the club's 21 games this season, and in two other contests he has logged 39 minutes. It's a trend that hasn't subsided for RMU's floor general since he became a regular starter for the club at the end of his freshman season. Coleman has played a full game's worth of action a total of 33 times in his Robert Morris career, including a pair of 45-minute stints thanks to overtime games. Since earning his first start against Sacred Heart back on Feb. 5, 2004, Coleman has averaged 35.4 minutes per game in 89 starts.

**Making It Count** - An area of strength for RMU under the direction of head coach **Mark Schmidt** has been the ability of the team to convert at the free-throw line. Robert Morris has finished in the top five in the Northeast Conference in free-throw percentage each of the previous five years, including a league-best 75.4 percent (384-for-576) in 2003-04. So far this season the Colonials lead the circuit in free throw percentage, converting 75.4 percent (267-for-354) of their opportunities. Robert Morris has been even better in pressure situations, converting a solid 82 percent (82-for-100) of its shots in the last five minutes and overtime of games. Senior guard **Derek Coleman** and senior forward **A.J. Jackson** have been at the stripe the most in crunch time, combining to hit 36 of their 41 opportunities (87.8 percent).

**Pop Goes the Weasel** - Junior guard **Tony Lee** was all over the court in RMU's 73-72 win over Duquesne (12/2/06), especially on defense. Lee broke a 19-year old Charles L. Sewall Center record for steals by registering eight against the Dukes, including three in the last 12:07 as RMU climbed out of a 10-point deficit. Lee's eight steals eclipsed the old record of seven, which was originally established by Drafton Davis of Marist. Davis recorded his seven thefts in a 61-57 overtime victory over the Colonials Feb. 28, 1987. Lee's eight steals is the seventh highest single-game total of the 2006-07 season in Division I, behind Travis Holmes of VMI (11 steals), Ledell Eackles of Campbell (10 steals) and Darren Collison of UCLA, Damian Martin of Loyola Marymount, Chavis Holmes of VMI and Kevin Bell of Fresno State, who each have posted nine steals.

**Creating & Creating** - Senior guard **Derek Coleman** has done a solid job this year doing what he does best: creating opportunities for his teammates. Coleman dished out six assists in a 76-68 win over Saint Francis (Pa.) (2/3/07) to push his career total to 404, becoming just the sixth Colonial in school history with 400 career dimes and the first since Javier Smith finished with 459 from 1994-98. Coleman currently is tops in the Northeast Conference in assists per game (5.52) and is on pace to finish the 2006-07 regular season with 437 dimes, which would rank fourth all-time at RMU.

Under Schmidt, Robert Morris boasts a record of 57-19 (.750) when holding opponents under 70 points a contest, including a mark of 8-2 on the 2006-07 season.

**Spread The Jam** - One of the strength's for Robert Morris on the 2006-07 campaign has been the club's ability to be unselfish, and it's a trend that has continued as the Colonials have returned to league play. In the last 13 contests RMU has converted a total of 363 field goals, with the club posting assists on 214 of those baskets. That equates to almost 60 percent (59.0) of the club's field goals. As a club so far this year Robert Morris is averaging **16.14** assists per game, which **leads** the Northeast Conference. The highest assist per game average by RMU in the six-year tenure of head coach **Mark Schmidt** is 15.2 dimes per contest, set in Schmidt's inaugural season as head coach in 2001-02.

**Daytona 500** - While junior guard **Tony Lee** has an outside shot of joining the 1,000-point club this season, barring injury he should almost assuredly eclipse the 500-rebound plateau. Lee enters Saturday's game with 486 career caroms, which ranks 18th all-time at Robert Morris. At his current pace (6.2 rpg), Lee is on pace to push his career total for rebounds to 523 by the end of the 2006-07 regular season, at total that would rank 10th all-time. There are currently 12 members in the 500-rebound club at Robert Morris.

**The Chase Is On** - For the second time in three seasons, the Robert Morris career record for three-point field goals could be challenged in 2006-07. Former Colonial Aaron Thomas (2000-04) established a new career record for three-pointers in 2003-04 by finishing his career with 218. That record was only 48 treys ahead of former Colonial Maurice Carter (2001-05) entering the 2004-05 campaign, but Carter hit just 47 in his senior season to finish second in the record books with 217 career three-pointers. Now, thanks to a career high 74 three-pointers in 2005-06, senior **Derek Coleman** entered his final season in 2006-07 a total of 78 three-pointers shy of breaking the record held by Thomas. Coleman owns 44 three-pointers so far on the 2006-07 season, pushing his career total to 185, which ranks fifth all-time at RMU. With six regular-season games remaining in 2006-07, Coleman needs 34 three-pointers to eclipse the record of 218 held by Thomas. Over that span Coleman will need to average 5.7 three-pointers per game.

**Home Is Where the Heart Is** - Senior forward **A.J. Jackson** has found the Charles L. Sewall Center to his liking. Dating back to the start of the 2005-06 campaign, Jackson has been as solid a player as any for the Colonials at home, averaging 18.7 points and 9.4 rebounds in 24 career games at the Sewall Center. Jackson became just the second Colonial in school history to average over 20 points per game at home last season when he scored at a 20.8 points per game clip. The only other Colonial to average over 20 points per contest in a season in the Sewall Center's 22-year history was RMU all-time leading scorer Myron Walker (1990-94), who averaged 21.1 points per game as a sophomore in 1991-92. Jackson also has an opportunity to post the best career scoring average by a Colonial at the Sewall Center. That mark is also held by Walker at 18.5 points per game. # Marshall Memorial Classic

**Home Sweet Home** - Robert Morris has learned to protect its home court at the Charles L. Sewall Center, as the Colonials notched a 96-72 win in its 2006-07 season opener over Florida International at home, a year after posting an 11-2 record at home. Thanks to a 9-2 record at the Sewall Center so far this season, RMU has posted a record of 50-25 (.667) at the home under sixth-year head coach **Mark Schmidt**. Overall in the 22-year history of the facility the Colonials have posted a record of 173-106 (.620).

**Four on the Floor** - Senior forward **A.J. Jackson** had his streak of 20+ point scoring games snapped at four when he finished with just eight points @ Monmouth (1/27/07). Despite that, it marked Jackson's second such streak of the 2006-07 season. In RMU's 4-0 start to the year, Jackson averaged 24.0 points per game and eclipsed the 20-point plateau in each contest. He became the first Colonial in school history to post a pair of streaks of at least four games scoring 20+ points in the same season and just the second player to turn the trick overall. Former Colonial Gene Nabors (1995-2000) also accomplished the feat twice, turning the trick in each of the 1998-99 and 1999-2000 campaigns. Jackson is also just the fifth player in school history to score at least 20 points in four straight games overall, as joining him and Nabors are former Colonials Myron Walker (1990-94), Keith Jones (1995-99) and Wesley Fluellen (1997-2002). Nabors is also the only Colonial in school history to have more than four games of scoring 20+ points in a contest, as he averaged 27.1 points over eight straight games late in the 1999-2000 season. **Streakers** - By finishing with eight points in a 59-56 setback @ Long Island, junior guard **Tony Lee** had his double-figure scoring streak snapped at 11 games. The streak was tied for the third longest by a Colonial on the active roster, and it also tied Lee's career-best streak. He scored in double figures in 11 straight contests from Jan. 26, 2006 to March 2, 2006. Sophomore guard **Jeremy Chappell** currently owns the longest double-figure scoring streak, which is five games.

### 2006 Northeast Conference Preseason Coaches Poll

According to a poll of league head coaches, Robert Morris was been picked to finish second in the Northeast Conference in 2006-07. It marks the highest preseason ranking for the Colonials ever, matching their second-place preseason prediction prior to the 1991-92 campaign. RMU received five first-place votes, with the other six going to Monmouth, which was tabbed as the preseason favorite.

Following Monmouth and Robert Morris in the top five in the poll are Long Island, Central Connecticut State and Quinnipiac. The Blue Devils and Bobcats were picked to tie for fourth in the poll. Rounding out the annual poll is Wagner, Fairleigh Dickinson, St. Francis (N.Y.), Sacred Heart, Mount St. Mary's and Saint Francis (Pa.).

As well as being picked second in the preseason poll, Robert Morris placed senior forward **A.J. Jackson** on the 2006-07 NEC preseason all-conference team. Joining Jackson are forwards Marques Alston of Monmouth and Obie Nwadike of Central Connecticut State and guards Jarrid Frye of Sacred Heart and James Williams of Long Island.

Conducted annually, NEC coaches have failed to correctly forecast the eventual league champion since selecting Mount St. Mary's to win it all in 1998-99, and have proven inaccurate in 17 of the last 19 years.

This year marks the eighth time that Monmouth has been selected the Northeast Conference's preseason favorite by league head coaches, the most in conference history by a wide margin.

## The Need for Three

The Colonials have relied heavily on the three-point shot under the direction of **Mark Schmidt** during his six years as head coach, with evidence the club's three-point field goal totals. In 2005-06 RMU shattered the team record for three-pointers with 260, eclipsing the club's old mark of 213, which was set in 2003-04. On the 2005-06 campaign, RMU averaged 8.97 three-pointers a game to lead the Northeast Conference. Since the start of the 2001-02 season, the Colonials lead the NEC in three-pointers made per game (7.46), ahead of St. Francis (N.Y.), which has averaged 7.06 three-pointers a contest.
