**Top Story** - The Robert Morris University men's basketball team closes out a two-game home-stand Sunday night by hosting Wagner at the Charles L. Sewall Center for a 7:00 p.m. Northeast Conference game. Originally scheduled for Feb. 15, 2007, the game was moved to Sunday night due to inclement weather in the Northeast. The Colonials are coming off a 102-97 double overtime loss to St. Francis (N.Y.) last night and currently are in a three-way tie for fifth place in the league standings with the Seahawks and Mount St. Mary's (8-8 NEC mark). Robert Morris takes to the road after tonight's game, traveling to Connecticut for league contests @ Central Conn. State (2/22/07) and @ Quinnipiac (2/14/07).

**Quick Stat of the Night** - Robert Morris enters tonight's game with Wagner having dropped two of its last three games at the Charles L. Sewall Center for the first time since closing out the 2003-04 campaign with home losses to Monmouth and Central Connecticut State sandwiched around a victory over Quinnipiac (2/21/04 to 2/28/04). The Colonials will look to avoid back-to-back losses at the Sewall Center for the first time since the 2004-05 campaign against the Seahawks, and defense will play a key role. Since opening the home portion of its NEC schedule with wins over Quinnipiac (1/4/06) and CCSU (1/6/06) and holding the two clubs to a shooting percentage of 43.1 percent (44-for-102), opponents have combined to shoot 52.8 percent (153-for-290) in the last five games.

#### Sunday's Opponent and the All-Time Series -

The Colonials and Seahawks will tipoff for the 50th time Thursday night, with Robert Morris holding a 28-21 advantage in the all-time series. Wagner has won two straight over the Colonials, both coming on Staten Island, N.Y. The Seahawks garnered a 72-60 win over RMU

in the first meeting of the 2006-07 campaign at the Spiro Sports Center (12/9/06). In that game junior guard **Tony Lee** paced the Colonials with 17 points while adding seven rebounds and three steals, while senior forward **A.J. Jackson** recorded 13 points and 11 boards.

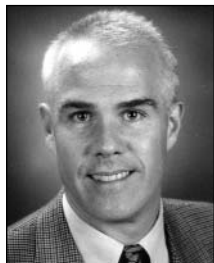

## Head Coach Mark Schmidt Sixth Season - Boston College '85



The 2006-07 campaign marks **Mark Schmidt's** sixth year as head coach of the men's basketball program at Robert Morris University. He owns an overall record of 80-87 (.479), including a 56-50 (.528) mark in the Northeast Conference, and was named to his current post May 7, 2001. Schmidt guided the Colonials to their first winning season in six years in 2005-06 with an overall record of 15-14, including 10-8 in conference action. He also led RMU to the NEC Tournament semifinals for the second time in the last three years in 2006. In 2003-04 and 2004-05, he led RMU to identical overall

records of 14-15. In 2001-02, Schmidt led Robert Morris to a 12-18 overall record, the most victories for a first-year head coach in the 30-year history of the Colonial men's basketball program.

Prior to RMU, Schmidt spent seven seasons as one of the nation's top assistants at Xavier University under current Wake Forest head coach Skip Prosser from 1994-2001. While with the Musketeers, Schmidt played a dual role, serving as both a coach and the program's top recruiter. His coaching responsibilities centered mostly around the post players, and he helped develop and recruit players at Xavier that have moved on to the professional ranks, including James Posey (Miami Heat), David West (New Orleans Hornets), Romain Sato (San Antonio Spurs), Lionel Chalmers (Minnesota Timberwolves) and David Young (Seattle Supersonics). Prior to his stint with Xavier, Schmidt served one year as an assistant at Loyola College in Baltimore, Md., also under Prosser. He also spent two seasons at Penn State University under Bruce Parkhill from 1991-93, and started his coaching career as an assistant at St. Michael's College in Vermont from 1989-91.

Schmidt's playing career was highlighted by four years as a guard/forward at Boston College, where he received his bachelor's degree in business administration and management with a concentration in marketing in 1985. The Eagles went 22-10 and made the NCAA Elite Eight during his freshman season in 1981-82 under head coach Tom Davis and 25-7 the next year in making the NCAA Tournament Sweet Sixteen in his first of three years playing for current Maryland coach Gary Williams. Boston College reached the NIT second round in 1984 and the NCAA Sweet Sixteen again in 1985.

**Scouting the Seahawks** - Wagner enters Sunday's game with an overall record of 10-15, including 7-7 in Northeast Conference play, and is coming off a 57-54 victory @ Saint Francis (Pa.) (2/17/07). The Seahawks have been led by junior guard Mark Porter, who averages 14.0 points, 4.9 rebounds and 4.96 assists per game. Porter eclipsed the 1,000-point plateau against the Red Flash by finishing with nine points and now owns 1,008 points on his career. The leading rebounder for Wagner has been junior guard James Ulrich, who pulls down an average of 6.5 boards a contest.

**Wagner Head Coach** - In his fourth season as head coach at Wagner and 23rd season overall is **Mike Deane (Potsdam State '74)**, who owns a career record of 393-281 (.583) entering Sunday's game against Robert Morris. Included in that overall record is a mark of 50-61 (.450) as head coach of the Seahawks.

**RMU's Last Game** - Jamaal Womack tied a Charles L. Sewall Center record for three-pointers with nine, including one that sent the game into overtime with three seconds left in regulation, en route to a 31-point performance that led St. Francis (N.Y.) to a 102-97 double overtime win over Robert Morris last night. Womack's nine three-pointers ties the record originally set by Scott Murphy of Mount St. Mary's Jan. 24, 1991. The Colonials held an 83-80 lead after senior guard **Derek Coleman** hit a pair of free throws with 10 seconds remaining in regulation after coming down with a defensive rebound and being fouled by John Gooden. However, Womack's trifecta from the left wing trickled through the basket to send the game to overtime. In the first extra period RMU took a 91-89 edge with 59 seconds to go on a jumper from senior forward **A.J. Jackson**, but Marcus Williams tied the game at 91-91 with 32 seconds to play with a pair of free throws. On the ensuing possession for Robert Morris, sophomore guard **Jeremy Chappell's** three-pointer was off the mark, sending the game to a second overtime. The Terriers jumped out to a 95-91 lead in the second extra frame as Womack hit a jumper and Bassith Yessoufou scored on a layup. St. Francis (N.Y.) had an opportunity to extend its lead even further, but Allan Sheppard missed a pair of free throws with 2:46 remaining. Jackson pulled the Colonials within two, 95-93, on a pair of free throws, and after a turnover by Williams at halfcourt on a steal junior guard **Tony Lee** scored a fastbreak layup to tie the game for the 17th time, 95-95, with 2:10 to play. Sheppard responded with a jumper on an assist from Gooden to give the Terriers a 97-95 edge with 40 seconds left in the second overtime, and Chappell again missed a three-pointer with 26 seconds to go, with Womack pulling down the rebound. He was fouled by Lee, and Womack hit both ends to help seal the victory. Womack set a career high with 31 points to lead five Terriers in double figures scoring, while Lee shot 13-for-18 from the floor to establish a career high with 31 points while adding six rebounds, six assists and three steals, while Coleman notched his third career double-double thanks to 16 points and a career-high tying 11 assists.

**St. Francis (N.Y.) Game Notes** - All five starters for Robert Morris established career highs in minutes played thanks to the double overtime contest, with senior guard **Derek Coleman** logging 48 minutes, the most of any player in the game ... The Colonials converted 53.2 percent (33-for-62) of their shots from the floor but allowed St. Francis (N.Y.) to shoot an even 50 percent (36-for-72) ... RMU was 0-for-7 from beyond the arc in the two extra frames after hitting 10 of its 20 opportunities in regulation ... The Terriers drained 12 three-pointers in the game, a season high ... Freshman guard **Mezie Nwigwe** contributed seven points off the bench thanks to 3-for-4 shooting from the field ... St. Francis (N.Y.) held a 37-34 edge on the backboard, including a 13-9 spread in offensive rebounds ... Junior guard **Tony Lee** was 0-for-3 in three-point field goal attempts but was 13-for-15 (86.7 percent) from inside the arc ... Robert Morris fell to 1-1 this season in overtime games, 2-2 under head coach **Mark Schmidt** and 21-20 in school history ... Both overtime losses under Schmidt have come against the Terriers ... The 102 points marked the most allowed by the Colonials since dropping a 129-120 decision to Long Island (2/3/97) at the Sewall Center.

**Forever in Lee Blue Jeans** - Junior guard **Tony Lee** posted the most points by a Colonial this season by establishing a career high with 31 points in RMU's double overtime defeat against St. Francis (N.Y.). Lee finished 13-for-18 from the field and has shot a solid 62.4 percent (83-for-133) from the field at the Sewall Center so far this season. Take away his three-point shooting at home, where Lee has converted just 25 percent (6-for-24) of his shots, and Lee's field goal percentage inside the arc jumps to an astounding **70.6 percent** (77-for-109). Lee leads the Colonials with a scoring average of 17.9 points per game at home this season, having scored in double figures in 11 of the club's 12 games.

**The Patriot** - Any success Robert Morris will have down the stretch of the 2006-07 season will depend in large part to the play of senior guard **Derek Coleman**. A natural playmaker, the Boston, Mass., product has also increased his offensive production since the calendar has switched to the year 2007. In 12 games since returning to league play, Coleman is averaging **15.3 points** per contest while shooting **49.1 percent** (**60-for-122**) from the floor. Even with the increased offensive output, it hasn't slowed Coleman down in creating opportunities for his teammates. In the same stretch Coleman is averaging **6.3 assists** per game, a big reason he leads the circuit in NEC games in the category (6.43 apg).

**Offensively Speaking** - Robert Morris enters Sunday's game against Wagner having seemingly hit its stride offensively, as the club has shot a solid **50.1 percent** (**417-for-833**) from the field in its last 15 games. Over that span the Colonials have shot 50 percent or better from the field **nine** times. Due to the surge, RMU owns a team shooting percentage of **47.6 percent** (**625-for-1,314**) on the season, which leads the Northeast Conference. The Colonials have never lead the league in field goal percentage in 26 years as part of the conference.

**Coleman's Court** - Senior guard **Derek Coleman** enters Sunday's game leading the Northeast Conference in assists with an average of **5.70** per game, a total that also ranks 30th in Division I. He's trying to become just the **third** player in league history to lead the circuit in assists in back-to-back years and first since Raasaan Johnson in 2000-01 (5.7 apg) and 2001-02 (5.3 apg). Former St. Francis (N.Y.) guard Greg Nunn posted averages of 5.6 and 6.1 assists per game, respectively, in 1998-99 and 1999-2000. Coleman led the NEC last year in assists per game (4.7).

**Coming Along** - Freshman guard **Mezie Nwigwe** has often been the first guard off the bench for Robert Morris this season, subbing for either junior guard **Tony Lee** or sophomore guard **Jeremy Chappell** in giving the Colonials a spark. With the 2006-07 regular season slowly winding down, Nwigwe has seemingly found his niche as part of the RMU rotation. In the last four games Nwigwe has shot a solid **61.5 percent** (**8-for-13**) from the floor. Over that span he has averaged 5.0 points per game despite playing an average of just 18.3 minutes per contest.

**Both Ends of the Floor** - Junior guard **Tony Lee** has been the most complete player for Robert Morris in 2006-07, and the evidence is in the numbers. Offensively, Lee ranks second for Robert Morris in scoring (15.9 ppg) while pacing the Northeast Conference in field goal percentage (.605). Defensively, Lee also leads the circuit in steals by averaging 2.83 per game. In the national rankings through games of Feb. 15, 2007, Lee ranks sixth in Division I in steals, while his field goal percentage ranks 25th. He is the only player from an NEC school to rank in the 25 top in two categories. A look at the numbers ...

**Triple Threat** - With junior guard **Tony Lee** leading the Northeast Conference in field goal percentage (60.5 percent) while ranking fifth in assists (4.17 per game), it has him approaching a milestone few have accomplished in the history of the league. With career totals of 946 points, 497 rebounds and 243 assists, Lee has an outside shot this season of becoming just the fifth player in league history to eclipse career totals of 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 250 assists. The last player to turn the trick was Kason Mims of Quinnipiac, who finished his career with 1,335 points, 548 caroms and 453 assists. If Lee were to eclipse those totals this season, he would be the first of the five to accomplish the feat as a junior.

**Combination Platter** - So far this season, Robert Morris has received 78.5 percent of its offense from its usual contributors in guards **Derek Coleman**, **Tony Lee** and **Jeremy Chappell** and forward **A.J. Jackson**. Despite that, dating back to the start of the 2005-06 campaign, when Coleman and Jackson combine to score more than 30 points in a game, the Colonials own a record of **18-6 (.750)**. Included in that is a mark of **9-3** so far this season.

**Zoom Zoom Zoom** - Junior guard **Tony Lee**, with 497 career rebounds to his credit entering Sunday's game against Wagner, has an opportunity to become the fastest Colonial to the 500-rebound mark in school history. Lee has accumulated his 497 rebounds in 80 career games, which equates to an average of 6.2 caroms per contest. RMU's all-time leading rebounder, Anthony Dickens (1985-90), grabbed his 500th rebound in his 81st career game. He finished with eight in a 70-59 victory @ Niagara (11/29/89) to eclipse the 500-rebound plateau, the fastest Colonial to go over the mark. Lee is just three rebounds shy of 500 for his career and will appear in his 81st career game Sunday against Wagner.

**Mr. Perfect** - Junior guard **Tony Lee** certainly could be looked at as RMU's most valuable player as the club is off to a 15-8 start to the 2006-07 season, and he probably was never more valuable in a game than in an 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/06). Lee finished a perfect 8-for-8 from the field, including 1-for-1 from beyond the arc, in scoring 17 points while adding a team high seven rebounds, four assists and two steals. The only other perfect day for a Robert Morris player on record with more than five field goal attempts was former Colonial Bubba Donnelly (1991-95), who finished 7-for-7 from the field for 21 points in an 80-59 win @ Rider (1/10/94). All seven of Donnelly's field goals in that game were three-pointers.

**Straight Shooter** - Junior guard **Tony Lee** hit his first six shots from the field in RMU's 83-38 win over Goucher (12/30/06) before missing a three-pointer with a minute to go in the first half. With that missed trifecta it ended a streak of 16 straight field goals for Lee dating back to the club's 79-78 win over Youngstown State (12/16/06). Lee hit his last two field goals against the Penguins, all eight of his shots in an 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/06) before hitting his first six shots from the floor against the Gophers.

**Hard to Imagine** - A very important part to senior guard **Derek Coleman's** offensive output over his four-year career has been the ability to knock down the three-point shot. Coleman owns 193 three-pointers on his career, which ranks fifth all-time at Robert Morris. However, in RMU's 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/04), Coleman finished with 14 points despite not hitting a three-pointer. He finished 4-for-10 from the field and a perfect 6-for-6 from the free-throw line for his 14 points but was 0-for-4 from beyond the arc. It marks the first time in his career Coleman, with 48 career double-figure scoring games to his credit, finished in double digits without hitting a three-pointer.

**The Strokes** - Despite having his consecutive streak of free throws snapped at 13 in a 76-68 win over Saint Francis (Pa.) (2/3/07), senior guard **Derek Coleman** still has shot **88 percent (22-for-25)** from the free-throw line in his last six games. Coleman's run marked his second double-digit streak of the 2006-07 campaign, as he hit 17 straight over a seven-game span in December and January. Coleman currently ranks second in the Northeast Conference with a free-throw percentage of **86.2 percent (56-for-65)** and could possibly be making runs at both the single-season and career records for free throw shooting. The single-season mark is held by former Colonial Brandon Welsch, who converted 87.7 percent (71-for-81) of his shots in 1998-99. The career record of 86 percent is held by former Colonial Tom Parks (1978-83). Coleman enters Sunday's game against Wagner with a career free-throw shooting percentage of 82.7 percent (177-for-214), which ranks third in the career record book at Robert Morris.

**Select Company** - Senior forward **A.J. Jackson**, a 2006-07 preseason All-Northeast Conference Team selection, put together one of his best games in a Colonial uniform in RMU's 73-69 win @ Marshall (11/17/06). Jackson finished with 30 points on 9-of-18 shooting and also compiled 15 rebounds, including six offensive boards, for his 15th career double-double. His 30-point effort marks the second time Jackson has hit the 30-point plateau in a contest, while his 15 rebounds marks the third time he has recorded at least 15 caroms in a game. A quick glance at the Robert Morris single-game records, and Jackson has an opportunity to post the most 30-point scoring games in school history and is already tied for the most games with 15+ rebounds. Former Colonial Myron Walker (1991-94) posted six games in which he scored 30 or more points, while former Colonials Earl Cureton (1976-77) and Anthony Dickens (1985-90) own three games of posting at least 15 rebounds in a game. **Clutch Shooting** - A number of Colonials have begun to show their penchant for clutch shooting late in ball games as Robert Morris enters the second half of the 2006-07 campaign. In a 73-69 victory @ Marshall (11/17/06) in the club's first road game of the season, senior forward **A.J. Jackson** and senior guard **Derek Coleman** each hit three-pointers in the last 1:35 of the contest to help propel the Colonials to victory. Coleman's three-pointer with 49 seconds to go gave Robert Morris the lead for good, and it marks his second career three-pointer in the last minute of a game that gave the Colonials a lead. Coleman drained a three-pointer with 12 seconds to play to lift RMU to a 69-68 victory @ Central Connecticut State (2/14/04) during his freshman campaign. Sophomore guard **Jeremy Chappell**, meanwhile, sunk a three-pointer with 12.3 seconds remaining to lift Robert Morris to a 67-66 win @ Mount St. Mary's (3/3/06) in the 2006 NEC Tournament quarterfinals.

**RMU Weekly Honors** - Senior forward **A.J. Jackson** (Northeast Conference *Choice Hotels* Player of the Week - 11/20/06) ... Senior forward **A.J. Jackson** (NEC *Choice Hotels* Player of the Week - 11/27/06) ... Junior guard **Tony Lee** (NEC *Choice Hotels* Player of the Week - 12/18/06) ... Junior guard **Tony Lee** (NEC *Choice Hotels* Player of the Week - 1/2/07).

**Running With the Devil** - Robert Morris has played some close ball games so far on the 2006-07 season, with the Colonials coming out on top. In games decided by five points or less RMU boasts a record of 7-4, including a pair of one-point victories. That mark has helped Robert Morris improve to 28-22 (.560) under sixth-year head coach **Mark Schmidt** in games decided by five points or less. However, basketball is a game of runs, and that has never been more prudent than with Robert Morris in 2006-07. In 21 of RMU's 23 games so far this season, the Colonials have either owned a double-digit lead or trailed by double digits.

**Iron Man** - Senior guard **Derek Coleman** doesn't get comfortable sitting on the bench during games. In fact, he rarely is off the court at all. Coleman enters Sunday's game against Wagner having played a full contest in 11 of the club's 23 games this season, and in two other contests he has logged 39 minutes. It's a trend that hasn't subsided for RMU's floor general since he became a regular starter for the club at the end of his freshman season. Coleman has played a full game's worth of action a total of 34 times in his Robert Morris career, including a 48-minute stint against St. Francis (N.Y.) (2/17/07). Since earning his first start against Sacred Heart back on Feb. 5, 2004, Coleman has averaged 35.6 minutes per game in 91 starts.

**Making It Count** - An area of strength for RMU under the direction of head coach **Mark Schmidt** has been the ability of the team to convert at the free-throw line. Robert Morris has finished in the top five in the Northeast Conference in free-throw percentage each of the previous five years, including a league-best 75.4 percent (384-for-576) in 2003-04. So far this season the Colonials lead the circuit in free throw percentage, converting 75.2 percent (303-for-403) of their opportunities. Robert Morris has been even better in pressure situations, converting a solid 81 percent (98-for-121) of its shots in the last five minutes and overtime of games. Senior guard **Derek Coleman** and senior forward **A.J. Jackson** have been at the stripe the most in crunch time, combining to hit 50 of their 58 opportunities (86.2 percent).

**Pop Goes the Weasel** - Junior guard **Tony Lee** was all over the court in RMU's 73-72 win over Duquesne (12/2/06), especially on defense. Lee broke a 19-year old Charles L. Sewall Center record for steals by registering eight against the Dukes, including three in the last 12:07 as RMU climbed out of a 10-point deficit. Lee's eight steals eclipsed the old record of seven, which was originally established by Drafton Davis of Marist. Davis recorded his seven thefts in a 61-57 overtime victory over the Colonials Feb. 28, 1987. Lee's eight steals is the seventh highest single-game total of the 2006-07 season in Division I, behind Travis Holmes of VMI (11 steals), Ledell Eackles of Campbell (10 steals) and Darren Collison of UCLA, Damian Martin of Loyola Marymount, Chavis Holmes of VMI and Kevin Bell of Fresno State, who each have posted nine steals.

**Creating & Creating** - Senior guard **Derek Coleman** has done a solid job this year doing what he does best: creating opportunities for his teammates. Coleman dished out six assists in a 76-68 win over Saint Francis (Pa.) (2/3/07) to push his career total to 404, becoming just the sixth Colonial in school history with 400 career dimes and the first since Javier Smith finished with 459 from 1994-98. Coleman currently is tops in the Northeast Conference in assists per game (5.70) and is on pace to finish the 2006-07 regular season with 441 dimes, which would rank fourth all-time at Robert Morris.

Under Schmidt, Robert Morris boasts a record of **58-19 (.753)** when holding opponents under 70 points a contest, including a mark of **9-2** on the 2006-07 season.

**Spread The Jam** - One of the strengths for Robert Morris on the 2006-07 campaign has been the club's ability to be unselfish, and it's a trend that has continued as the Colonials have returned to league play. In the last 15 contests RMU has converted a total of 417 field goals, with the club posting assists on 245 of those baskets. That equates to almost 60 percent (58.7) of the club's field goals. As a club so far this year Robert Morris is averaging **16.09** assists per game, which **leads** the Northeast Conference. The highest assist per game average by RMU in the six-year tenure of head coach **Mark Schmidt** is 15.2 dimes per contest, set in Schmidt's inaugural season as head coach in 2001-02.

**Daytona 500** - While junior guard **Tony Lee** has an outside shot of joining the 1,000-point club this season, barring injury he should almost assuredly eclipse the 500-rebound plateau. Lee enters Sunday's game with 497 career caroms, which ranks 13th all-time at Robert Morris. At his current pace (6.1 rpg), Lee is on pace to push his career total for rebounds to 521 by the end of the 2006-07 regular season, at total that would rank 10th all-time. There are currently 12 members in the 500-rebound club at Robert Morris.

**The Chase Is On** - For the second time in three seasons, the Robert Morris career record for three-point field goals could be challenged in 2006-07. Former Colonial Aaron Thomas (2000-04) established a new career record for three-pointers in 2003-04 by finishing his career with 218. That record was only 48 treys ahead of former Colonial Maurice Carter (2001-05) entering the 2004-05 campaign, but Carter hit just 47 in his senior season to finish second in the record books with 217 career three-pointers. Now, thanks to a career high 74 three-pointers in 2005-06, senior **Derek Coleman** entered his final season in 2006-07 a total of 78 three-pointers shy of breaking the record held by Thomas. Coleman owns 52 three-pointers so far on the 2006-07 season, pushing his career total to 193, which ranks fifth all-time at RMU. With four regular-season games remaining in 2006-07, Coleman needs 26 three-pointers to eclipse the record of 218 held by Thomas. Over that span Coleman will need to average 6.5 three-pointers per game.

**Home Is Where the Heart Is** - Senior forward **A.J. Jackson** has found the Charles L. Sewall Center to his liking. Dating back to the start of the 2005-06 campaign, Jackson has been as solid a player as any for the Colonials at home, averaging 18.6 points and 9.3 rebounds in 25 career games at the Sewall Center. Jackson became just the second Colonial in school history to average over 20 points per game at home last season when he scored at a 20.8 points per game clip. The only other Colonial to average over 20 points per contest in a season in the Sewall Center's 22-year history was RMU all-time leading scorer Myron Walker (1990-94), who averaged 21.1 points per game as a sophomore in 1991-92. Jackson also has an opportunity to post the best career scoring average by a Colonial at the Sewall Center. That mark is also held by Walker at 18.5 points per game. # Marshall Memorial Classic



**Home Sweet Home** - Robert Morris has learned to protect its home court at the Charles L. Sewall Center, as the Colonials notched a 96-72 win in its 2006-07 season opener over Florida International at home, a year after posting an 11-2 record at home. Thanks to a 9-3 record at the Sewall Center so far this season, RMU has posted a record of 50-26 (.657) at the home under sixth-year head coach **Mark Schmidt**. Overall in the 22-year history of the facility the Colonials have posted a record of 173-107 (.618).

**Four on the Floor** - Senior forward **A.J. Jackson** had his streak of 20+ point scoring games snapped at four when he finished with just eight points @ Monmouth (1/27/07). Despite that, it marked Jackson's second such streak of the 2006-07 season. In RMU's 4-0 start to the year, Jackson averaged 24.0 points per game and eclipsed the 20-point plateau in each contest. He became the first Colonial in school history to post a pair of streaks of at least four games scoring 20+ points in the same season and just the second player to turn the trick overall. Former Colonial Gene Nabors (1995-2000) also accomplished the feat twice, turning the trick in each of the 1998-99 and 1999-2000 campaigns. Jackson is also just the fifth player in school history to score at least 20 points in four straight games overall, as joining him and Nabors are former Colonials Myron Walker (1990-94), Keith Jones (1995-99) and Wesley Fluellen (1997-2002). Nabors is also the only Colonial in school history to have more than four games of scoring 20+ points in a contest, as he averaged 27.1 points over eight straight games late in the 1999-2000 season. The streak was tied for the third longest by a Colonial on the active roster, and it also tied Lee's career-best streak. He scored in double figures in 11 straight contests from Jan. 26, 2006 to March 2, 2006. Senior forward **A.J. Jackson** currently owns the longest double-figure scoring streak, which is four games.

### 2006 Northeast Conference Preseason Coaches Poll

According to a poll of league head coaches, Robert Morris was been picked to finish second in the Northeast Conference in 2006-07. It marks the highest preseason ranking for the Colonials ever, matching their second-place preseason prediction prior to the 1991-92 campaign. RMU received five first-place votes, with the other six going to Monmouth, which was tabbed as the preseason favorite.

Following Monmouth and Robert Morris in the top five in the poll are Long Island, Central Connecticut State and Quinnipiac. The Blue Devils and Bobcats were picked to tie for fourth in the poll. Rounding out the annual poll is Wagner, Fairleigh Dickinson, St. Francis (N.Y.), Sacred Heart, Mount St. Mary's and Saint Francis (Pa.).

As well as being picked second in the preseason poll, Robert Morris placed senior forward **A.J. Jackson** on the 2006-07 NEC preseason all-conference team. Joining Jackson are forwards Marques Alston of Monmouth and Obie Nwadike of Central Connecticut State and guards Jarrid Frye of Sacred Heart and James Williams of Long Island.

Conducted annually, NEC coaches have failed to correctly forecast the eventual league champion since selecting Mount St. Mary's to win it all in 1998-99, and have proven inaccurate in 17 of the last 19 years.

This year marks the eighth time that Monmouth has been selected the Northeast Conference's preseason favorite by league head coaches, the most in conference history by a wide margin.

## The Need for Three

The Colonials have relied heavily on the three-point shot under the direction of **Mark Schmidt** during his six years as head coach, with evidence the club's three-point field goal totals. In 2005-06 RMU shattered the team record for three-pointers with 260, eclipsing the club's old mark of 213, which was set in 2003-04. On the 2005-06 campaign, RMU averaged 8.97 three-pointers a game to lead the Northeast Conference. Since the start of the 2001-02 season, the Colonials lead the NEC in three-pointers made per game (7.48), ahead of St. Francis (N.Y.), which has averaged 7.04 three-pointers a contest.
