Top Story - The Robert Morris University men's basketball team closes out a two-game road trip through Connecticut Saturday afternoon when it travels to Hamden, Conn., for a noon Northeast Conference game against Quinnipiac. The Colonials are coming off an 88-86 defeat @ Central Connecticut State (2/24/07) to open the trip and will look to clinch a spot in the 2007 NEC Tournament with a victory over the Bobcats. After Sunday's game with Quinnipiac, RMU closes out its 2006-07 regular season with a 7:00 p.m. tilt at home against Long Island. The NEC Tournament is set for March 1, 4 and 7 at campus sites.

Quick Stat of the Night - Looking for the statistical oddity of the century? Try this one on for size: Entering Saturday's game against Quinnipiac, senior guard **Derek Coleman** is four points shy of 1,000 for his career, while junior guard **Tony Lee** is just 13 points shy of eclipsing the same plateau. While there have been instances of two players from the same high school scoring 1,000 points for the same collegiate squad, what are the chances that two players from the same high school went over 1,000 career points not only in the same season, but the same game? Coleman and Lee were teammates under head coach Jack O'Brien at Charlestown High School in Boston, Mass., for three seasons from 2000-03, winning three state championships.

Saturday's Opponent and the All-Time Series - Robert Morris and Quinnipiac will meet for the 17th time Saturday afternoon, with RMU holding a 10-6 advantage in the all-time series. The Colonials have won four straight over the Bobcats and six of the last seven meetings. Included in that stretch is three straight victories for Robert Morris in Hamden, Conn. In the first meeting of the 2006-07 season series, RMU garnered an 86-68 victory at the Charles L. Sewall Center (1/4/07). Junior guard **Tony Lee** paced the Colonials in the victory with 20 points, including 14 in the second half, while sophomore guard **Jeremy Chappell** added 18 points and senior center **Freddie Harris** 12.

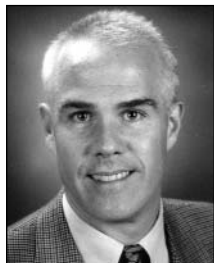

Head Coach Mark Schmidt Sixth Season - Boston College '85



The 2006-07 campaign marks **Mark Schmidt's** sixth year as head coach of the men's basketball program at Robert Morris University. He owns an overall record of 81-88 (.479), including a 57-51 (.528) mark in the Northeast Conference, and was named to his current post May 7, 2001. Schmidt guided the Colonials to their first winning season in six years in 2005-06 with an overall record of 15-14, including 10-8 in conference action. He also led RMU to the NEC Tournament semifinals for the second time in the last three years in 2006. In 2003-04 and 2004-05, he led RMU to identical overall

records of 14-15. In 2001-02, Schmidt led Robert Morris to a 12-18 overall record, the most victories for a first-year head coach in the 30-year history of the Colonial men's basketball program.

Prior to RMU, Schmidt spent seven seasons as one of the nation's top assistants at Xavier University under current Wake Forest head coach Skip Prosser from 1994-2001. While with the Musketeers, Schmidt played a dual role, serving as both a coach and the program's top recruiter. His coaching responsibilities centered mostly around the post players, and he helped develop and recruit players at Xavier that have moved on to the professional ranks, including James Posey (Miami Heat), David West (New Orleans Hornets), Romain Sato (San Antonio Spurs), Lionel Chalmers (Minnesota Timberwolves) and David Young (Seattle Supersonics). Prior to his stint with Xavier, Schmidt served one year as an assistant at Loyola College in Baltimore, Md., also under Prosser. He also spent two seasons at Penn State University under Bruce Parkhill from 1991-93, and started his coaching career as an assistant at St. Michael's College in Vermont from 1989-91.

Schmidt's playing career was highlighted by four years as a guard/forward at Boston College, where he received his bachelor's degree in business administration and management with a concentration in marketing in 1985. The Eagles went 22-10 and made the NCAA Elite Eight during his freshman season in 1981-82 under head coach Tom Davis and 25-7 the next year in making the NCAA Tournament Sweet Sixteen in his first of three years playing for current Maryland coach Gary Williams. Boston College reached the NIT second round in 1984 and the NCAA Sweet Sixteen again in 1985.

Scouting the Bobcats - Quinnipiac enters Saturday's game with Robert Morris sporting an overall record of 12-13, including 10-6 in Northeast Conference play. The Bobcats are currently tied for second place in the league standings with Sacred Heart and already have clinched a spot in the 2007 NEC Tournament. Quinnipiac is coming off a 73-72 loss to Saint Francis (Pa.) (2/22/07) at home in which junior guard DeMario Anderson paced the club with 25 points while grabbing four rebounds and notching a pair of assists, blocks and steals. Anderson is averaging 15.2 points per game entering Saturday's tilt, while the leading rebounder has been senior center Victor Akinyanju, who pulls down an average of 7.1 caroms per contest.

Quinnipiac Head Coach - In his 11th season as head coach of the Bobcats is **Joe DeSantis (Fairfield '79)**, who owns a career record of 116-186 (.384), all with Quinnipiac. DeSantis has seen transformation from Division II to Division I for the Bobcats.

RMU's Last Game - Senior guard **Derek Coleman's** jumper with less than a second to play hit the front end of the rim and Central Connecticut State climbed out of an eight-point deficit in the last six minutes to down RMU, 88-86, Feb. 22. CCSU owned a 60-54 lead with 11:08 remaining after a three-pointer from Tristan Blackwood, but RMU responded with a 14-1 surge to take a 68-61 lead with 6:43 to go. Sophomore guard **Jeremy Chappell** started the run with a three-pointer and finished with seven points during the run, while junior guard **Tony Lee** also added seven points. A layup from Jemino Sobers helped the Blue Devils close their deficit to five, 68-63, but the Colonial lead was extended to eight, 71-63, with exactly six minutes to play when freshman guard **Mezie Nwigwe** drained a three-pointer. Blackwood hit a three-pointer and Javier Mojica would add a layup to close Central Connecticut State within three, 71-68, but Chappell answered with a trifecta of his own to give Robert Morris a 74-68 edge. Blackwood's antics from beyond the arc continued, as his three-pointer on the next CCSU possession pulled the Blue Devils within one possession again, 74-71, and after a Coleman turnover Mojica hit a pair from the free-throw line to get Central Connecticut State within one, 74-73, with 4:08 to go. Lee helped RMU stay ahead by hitting one of his two opportunities at the charity stripe, but Blackwood hit his fifth three-pointer of the half to push the Blue Devils in front, 75-74, with 3:40 remaining. After a few missed opportunities by both clubs, Coleman scored a fastbreak layup on a feed from Lee to push the Colonials back in front, 77-76. However, with 2:13 to play senior forward **A.J. Jackson** was called for a technical, and Blackwood drained both of his shots from the free-throw line to push Central back in front, 78-77. On the ensuing possession for the Blue Devils, Sobers hit a runner in the paint to up the lead to 80-77 with 2:01 remaining. Robert Morris clawed back, as Lee's layup with 1:39 to go closed the Colonials to within one, 80-79, but Obie Nwadike's layup at the 1:11 mark of the second half kept it a three-point lead for Central, 82-79.

Central Conn. State Game Notes - Robert Morris held a 44-38 halftime lead thanks to a shooting percentage of 61.3 percent (19-for-31) in the first half ... On the game the Colonials shot 57.4 percent (35-for-61), while CCSU converted 43.9 percent (29-for-66) of its field goal attempts ... Senior guard **Derek Coleman** finished with just six points and is still four shy of 1,000 for his career ... Junior guard **Tony Lee** now needs just 13 points for 1,000 for his career and once he eclipses the plateau would become just the sixth player in league annals, and first as a junior, to go over career totals of 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 250 assists ... Lee owns 513 career caroms and 257 dimes ... RMU dominated points in the paint, 44-28 ... The Blue Devils held a 37-36 edge on the glass, including a 19-11 advantage in offensive rebounds ... Robert Morris posted 20 assists on its 35 field goals.

Forever in Lee Blue Jeans - Junior guard **Tony Lee** didn't mind playing on back-to-back nights in RMU's last homestand, pouring in a career high 31 points against St. Francis (N.Y.) (2/17/07) before posting 25 points in a 71-63 victory over Wagner (2/18/07). Lee has seemingly saved his basketball for the stretch run of the 2006-07 campaign, as in the last **eight** games he has averaged **19.8** points, **5.9** rebounds and **4.6** assists per contest while shooting **57.8** percent (**57-for-99**) from the field. Lee ranks second on the club in scoring at 16.2 points per game, just a shade behind senior forward **A.J. Jackson**, who is averaging 16.3 points a contest.

The Patriot - Any success Robert Morris will have down the stretch of the 2006-07 season will depend in large part to the play of senior guard **Derek Coleman**. A natural playmaker, the Boston, Mass., product has also increased his offensive production since the calendar has switched to the year 2007. In 14 games since returning to league play, Coleman is averaging **14.4** points per contest while shooting **47.4** percent (**66-for-139**) from the floor. Even with the increased offensive output, it hasn't slowed Coleman down in creating opportunities for his teammates. In the same stretch Coleman is averaging **5.9** assists per game, a big reason he leads the circuit in NEC games in the category (6.2 apg).

Double Nickel on a Dime - Junior guard **Tony Lee** paced Robert Morris with six assists in the club's 71-63 victory over Wagner (2/18/07), the ninth time this season he has either led or tied for the team lead in dimes in a game. Thanks to eight more assists @ Central Conn. State (2/22/07), Lee pushed his season total in the category to 110, second on the club behind senior guard **Derek Coleman** (138). Coleman and Lee are the first **pair** of RMU teammates to post at least **100** assists in a season since the **1990-91** campaign, when Andre Boyd (137) and Wade Timmerson (126) turned the trick. Coleman and Lee are also just the **third** pair **overall** to accomplish the feat, joining former guards Forest Grant and Chipper Harris, who each finished with at least 100 assists in three straight seasons from 1981 to 1984.

Offensively Speaking - Robert Morris enters Saturday's Northeast Conference game @ Quinnipiac having seemingly hit its stride offensively, as the club has shot a solid **50.6** percent (**478-for-945**) from the field in its last 17 games. Over that span the Colonials have shot 50 percent or better from the field **11** times. Due to the surge, RMU owns a team shooting percentage of **48.1** percent (**686-for-1,426**) on the season, which leads the Northeast Conference. The Colonials have never lead the league in field goal percentage in 26 years as part of the conference.

Coleman's Court - Senior guard **Derek Coleman** enters Saturday's game leading the Northeast Conference in assists with an average of **5.52** per game, a total that also ranks 22nd in Division I. He's trying to become just the **third** player in league history to lead the circuit in assists in back-to-back years and first since Rahsaan Johnson in 2000-01 (5.7 apg) and 2001-02 (5.3 apg). Former St. Francis (N.Y.) guard Greg Nunn posted averages of 5.6 and 6.1 assists per game, respectively, in 1998-99 and 1999-2000. Coleman led the NEC last year in assists per game (4.7). Drafton Davis of Marist is also a two-time assist leader in the NEC, as he paced the circuit with an average of 8.0 in 1985-86 before leading the league two years later with an average of 7.7 in 1987-88.

Both Ends of the Floor - Junior guard **Tony Lee** has been the most complete player for Robert Morris in 2006-07, and the evidence is in the numbers. Offensively, Lee is tied for the team lead in scoring (16.2 ppg) while pacing the Northeast Conference in field goal percentage (.602). Defensively, Lee also leads the circuit in steals by averaging 2.88 per game. In the national rankings through games of Feb. 18, 2007, Lee ranks seventh in Division I in steals, while his field goal percentage ranks 20th. He is one of just two players from an NEC school to rank in the 20 top in two categories, joining Central Connecticut State guard Tristan Blackwood. A look at the numbers ...

Triple Threat - With junior guard **Tony Lee** leading the Northeast Conference in field goal percentage (60.2 percent) while ranking fifth in assists (4.40 per game), it has him approaching a milestone few have accomplished in the history of the league. With career totals of 987 points, 513 rebounds and 256 assists, Lee should become just the sixth player in league history, and second this season, to eclipse career totals of 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 250 assists. The last player to turn the trick was Jarrid Frye of Sacred Heart, who joined the club when grabbing his 500th rebound Feb. 10 against Wagner. If Lee were to eclipse those totals this season, he would be the first to accomplish the feat as a junior.

Combination Platter - So far this season, Robert Morris has received 78.9 percent of its offense from its usual contributors in guards **Derek Coleman**, **Tony Lee** and **Jeremy Chappell** and forward **A.J. Jackson**. Despite that, dating back to the start of the 2005-06 campaign, when Coleman and Jackson combine to score more than 30 points in a game, the Colonials own a record of **18-6 (.750)**. Included in that is a mark of **9-3** so far this season.

Zoom Zoom Zoom - Junior guard **Tony Lee** picked up his 500th career rebound in RMU's 71-63 win over Wagner (2/18/07) when he finished with eight. Lee entered the game needing just three rebounds for 500 and now owns 513 for his career entering Saturday's game @ Quinnipiac. Lee also tied the school record for fastest to 500 rebounds, as he accomplished the feat in his 81st career game. RMU's all-time leading rebounder, Anthony Dickens, also notched his 500th career carom in his 81st career game, a 70-59 victory @ Niagara (11/29/89).

Mr. Perfect - Junior guard **Tony Lee** certainly could be looked at as RMU's most valuable player as the club is off to a 15-8 start to the 2006-07 season, and he probably was never more valuable in a game than in an 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/06). Lee finished a perfect 8-for-8 from the field, including 1-for-1 from beyond the arc, in scoring 17 points while adding a team high seven rebounds, four assists and two steals. The only other perfect day for a Robert Morris player on record with more than five field goal attempts was former Colonial Bubba Donnelly (1991-95), who finished 7-for-7 from the field for 21 points in an 80-59 win @ Rider (1/10/94). All seven of Donnelly's field goals in that game were three-pointers.

Hard to Imagine - A very important part to senior guard **Derek Coleman's** offensive output over his four-year career has been the ability to knock down the three-point shot. Coleman owns 195 three-pointers on his career, which ranks fifth all-time at Robert Morris. However, in RMU's 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/04), Coleman finished with 14 points despite not hitting a three-pointer. He finished 4-for-10 from the field and a perfect 6-for-6 from the free-throw line for his 14 points but was 0-for-4 from beyond the arc. It marks the first time in his career Coleman, with 49 career double-figure scoring games to his credit, finished in double digits without hitting a three-pointer.

The Strokes - Despite having his consecutive streak of free throws snapped at 13 in a 76-68 win over Saint Francis (Pa.) (2/3/07), senior guard **Derek Coleman** still has shot **89.7 percent (26-for-29)** from the free-throw line in his last nine games. Coleman's run marked his second double-digit streak of the 2006-07 campaign, as he hit 17 straight over a seven-game span in December and January. Coleman currently ranks second in the Northeast Conference with a free-throw percentage of **87 percent (60-for-69)** and could possibly be making runs at both the single-season and career records for free throw shooting. The single-season mark is held by former Colonial **Brandon Welsch**, who converted 87.7 percent (71-for-81) of his shots in 1998-99. The career record of 86 percent is held by former Colonial **Tom Parks (1978-83)**. Coleman enters Thursday's game @ CCSU with a career free-throw shooting percentage of 83 percent (181-for-218), which ranks third in the career record book at Robert Morris.

Select Company - Senior forward **A.J. Jackson**, a 2006-07 preseason All-Northeast Conference Team selection, put together one of his best games in a Colonial uniform in RMU's 73-69 win @ Marshall (11/17/06). Jackson finished with 30 points on 9-of-18 shooting and also compiled 15 rebounds, including six offensive boards, for his 15th career double-double. His 30-point effort marks the second time Jackson has hit the 30-point plateau in a contest, while his 15 rebounds marks the third time he has recorded at least 15 caroms in a game. A quick glance at the Robert Morris single-game records, and Jackson has an opportunity to post the most 30-point scoring games in school history and is already tied for the most games with 15+ rebounds. Former Colonial **Myron Walker (1991-94)** posted six games in which he scored 30 or more points, while former Colonials **Earl Cureton (1976-77)** and **Anthony Dickens (1985-90)** own three games of posting at least 15 rebounds in a game. Clutch Shooting - A number of Colonials have begun to show their penchant for clutch shooting late in ball games as Robert Morris enters the second half of the 2006-07 campaign. In a 73-69 victory @ Marshall (11/17/06) in the club's first road game of the season, senior forward **A.J. Jackson** and senior guard **Derek Coleman** each hit three-pointers in the last 1:35 of the contest to help propel the Colonials to victory. Coleman's three-pointer with 49 seconds to go gave Robert Morris the lead for good, and it marks his second career three-pointer in the last minute of a game that gave the Colonials a lead. Coleman drained a three-pointer with 12 seconds to play to lift RMU to a 69-68 victory @ Central Connecticut State (2/14/04) during his freshman campaign. Sophomore guard **Jeremy Chappell**, meanwhile, sunk a three-pointer with 12.3 seconds remaining to lift Robert Morris to a 67-66 win @ Mount St. Mary's (3/3/06) in the 2006 NEC Tournament quarterfinals.

Straight Shooter - Junior guard **Tony Lee** hit his first six shots from the field in RMU's 83-38 win over Goucher (12/30/06) before missing a three-pointer with a minute to go in the first half. With that missed trifecta it ended a streak of 16 straight field goals for Lee dating back to the club's 79-78 win over Youngstown State (12/16/06). Lee hit his last two field goals against the Penguins, all eight of his shots in an 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/06) before hitting his first six shots from the floor against the Gophers.

Running With the Devil - Robert Morris has played some close ball games so far on the 2006-07 season, with the Colonials coming out on top. In games decided by five points or less RMU boasts a record of 7-5, including a pair of one-point victories. That mark has helped Robert Morris improve to 28-23 (.549) under sixth-year head coach **Mark Schmidt** in games decided by five points or less. However, basketball is a game of runs, and that has never been more prudent than with Robert Morris in 2006-07. In 21 of RMU's 25 games so far this season, the Colonials have either owned a double-digit lead or trailed by double digits.

Iron Man - Senior guard **Derek Coleman** doesn't get comfortable sitting on the bench during games. In fact, he rarely is off the court at all. Coleman enters Saturday's game @ Quinnipiac having played a full contest in 12 of the club's 25 games this season, and in two other contests he has logged 39 minutes. It's a trend that hasn't subsided for RMU's floor general since he became a regular starter for the club at the end of his freshman season. Coleman has played a full game's worth of action a total of 35 times in his Robert Morris career, including a 48-minute stint against St. Francis (N.Y.) (2/17/07). Since earning his first start against Sacred Heart back on Feb. 5, 2004, Coleman has averaged 35.5 minutes per game in 93 starts.

Making It Count - An area of strength for RMU under the direction of head coach **Mark Schmidt** has been the ability of the team to convert at the free-throw line. Robert Morris has finished in the top five in the Northeast Conference in free-throw percentage each of the previous five years, including a league-best 75.4 percent (384-for-576) in 2003-04. So far this season the Colonials lead the circuit in free throw percentage, converting 75.3 percent (326-for-433) of their opportunities. Robert Morris has been even better in pressure situations, converting a solid 82.4 percent (108-for-131) of its shots in the last five minutes and overtime of games. Senior guard **Derek Coleman** and senior forward **A.J. Jackson** have been at the stripe the most in crunch time, combining to hit 54 of their 62 opportunities (87 percent).

Pop Goes the Weasel - Junior guard **Tony Lee** was all over the court in RMU's 73-72 win over Duquesne (12/2/06), especially on defense. Lee broke a 19-year old Charles L. Sewall Center record for steals by registering eight against the Dukes, including three in the last 12:07 as RMU climbed out of a 10-point deficit. Lee's eight steals eclipsed the old record of seven, which was originally established by Drafton Davis of Marist. Davis recorded his seven thefts in a 61-57 overtime victory over the Colonials Feb. 28, 1987. Lee's eight steals is the seventh highest single-game total of the 2006-07 season in Division I, behind Travis Holmes of VMI (11 steals), Ledell Eackles of Campbell (10 steals) and Darren Collison of UCLA, Damian Martin of Loyola Marymount, Chavis Holmes of VMI and Kevin Bell of Fresno State, who each have posted nine steals.

Creating & Creating - Senior guard **Derek Coleman** has done a solid job this year doing what he does best: creating opportunities for his teammates. Coleman dished out six assists in a 76-68 win over Saint Francis (Pa.) (2/3/07) to push his career total to 404, becoming just the sixth Colonial in school history with 400 career dimes and the first since Javier Smith finished with 459 from 1994-98. Coleman currently is tops in the Northeast Conference in assists per game (5.58) and is on pace to finish the 2006-07 regular season with 438 dimes, which would rank fourth all-time at Robert Morris.

Spread The Jam - One of the strengths for Robert Morris on the 2006-07 campaign has been the club's ability to be unselfish, and it's a trend that has continued as the Colonials have returned to league play. In the last 17 contests RMU has converted a total of 478 field goals, with the club posting assists on 278 of those baskets. That equates to almost 60 percent (58.2) of the club's field goals. As a club so far this year Robert Morris is averaging **16.12** assists per game, which **leads** the Northeast Conference. The highest assist per game average by RMU in the six-year tenure of head coach **Mark Schmidt** is 15.2 dimes per contest, set in Schmidt's inaugural season as head coach in 2001-02.

Daytona 500 - Junior guard **Tony Lee** became the 13th member of the Robert Morris 500-rebound club in RMU's 71-63 victory over Wagner (2/18/07) when he finished with eight boards, pushing his career total to 505. Lee is the fourth Colonial in six years to eclipse the 500-rebound plateau under head coach Mark Schmidt, joining Matt Smith (1998-2002), Aaron Thomas (2000-04) and Chaz McCrommon (2000-05). Thanks to an average of 6.2 rebounds per game this season, Lee is on pace to finish the 2006-07 regular season with 526 rebounds, which would rank 10th all-time.

The Chase Is On - For the second time in three seasons, the Robert Morris career record for three-point field goals could be challenged in 2006-07. Former Colonial Aaron Thomas (2000-04) established a new career record for three-pointers in 2003-04 by finishing his career with 218. That record was only 48 treys ahead of former Colonial Maurice Carter (2001-05) entering the 2004-05 campaign, but Carter hit just 47 in his senior season to finish second in the record books with 217 career three-pointers. Now, thanks to a career high 74 three-pointers in 2005-06, senior **Derek Coleman** entered his final season in 2006-07 a total of 78 three-pointers shy of breaking the record held by Thomas. Coleman owns 54 three-pointers so far on the 2006-07 season, pushing his career total to 195, which ranks fifth all-time at RMU. With four regular-season games remaining in 2006-07, Coleman needs 24 three-pointers to eclipse the record of 218 held by Thomas. Over that span Coleman will need to average 12.0 three-pointers per game.

Home Is Where the Heart Is - Senior forward **A.J. Jackson** has found the Charles L. Sewall Center to his liking. Dating back to the start of the 2005-06 campaign, Jackson has been as solid a player as any for the Colonials at home, averaging 18.6 points and 9.2 rebounds in 26 career games at the Sewall Center. Jackson became just the second Colonial in school history to average over 20 points per game at home last season when he scored at a 20.8 points per game clip. The only other Colonial to average over 20 points per contest in a season in the Sewall Center's 22-year history was RMU all-time leading scorer Myron Walker (1990-94), who averaged 21.1 points per game as a sophomore in 1991-92. Jackson also has an opportunity to post the best career scoring average by a Colonial at the Sewall Center. That mark is also held by Walker at 18.5 points per game. While Chappell is well on his way to becoming a 1,000-point scorer at RMU after a freshman campaign in which he was named the 2006 NEC Rookie of the Year, Coleman, Jackson and Lee each entered this season with outside shots of joining RMU's 1,000-point club. Marshall Memorial Classic

Home Sweet Home - Robert Morris has learned to protect its home court at the Charles L. Sewall Center, as the Colonials notched a 96-72 win in its 2006-07 season opener over Florida International at home, a year after posting an 11-2 record at home. Thanks to a 10-3 record at the Sewall Center so far this season, RMU has posted a record of 51-26 (.662) at the home under sixth-year head coach **Mark Schmidt**. Overall in the 22-year history of the facility the Colonials have posted a record of 174-107 (.621).

Four on the Floor - Senior forward **A.J. Jackson** had his streak of 20+ point scoring games snapped at four when he finished with just eight points @ Monmouth (1/27/07). Despite that, it marked Jackson's second such streak of the 2006-07 season. In RMU's 4-0 start to the year, Jackson averaged 24.0 points per game and eclipsed the 20-point plateau in each contest. He became the first Colonial in school history to post a pair of streaks of at least four games scoring 20+ points in the same season and just the second player to turn the trick overall. Former Colonial Gene Nabors (1995-2000) also accomplished the feat twice, turning the trick in each of the 1998-99 and 1999-2000 campaigns. Jackson is also just the fifth player in school history to score at least 20 points in four straight games overall, as joining him and Nabors are former Colonials Myron Walker (1990-94), Keith Jones (1995-99) and Wesley Fluellen (1997-2002). Nabors is also the only Colonial in school history to have more than four games of scoring 20+ points in a contest, as he averaged 27.1 points over eight straight games late in the 1999-2000 season. 2006 Northeast Conference Preseason Coaches Poll

According to a poll of league head coaches, Robert Morris was been picked to finish second in the Northeast Conference in 2006-07. It marks the highest preseason ranking for the Colonials ever, matching their second-place preseason prediction prior to the 1991-92 campaign. RMU received five first-place votes, with the other six going to Monmouth, which was tabbed as the preseason favorite.

Following Monmouth and Robert Morris in the top five in the poll are Long Island, Central Connecticut State and Quinnipiac. The Blue Devils and Bobcats were picked to tie for fourth in the poll. Rounding out the annual poll is Wagner, Fairleigh Dickinson, St. Francis (N.Y.), Sacred Heart, Mount St. Mary's and Saint Francis (Pa.).

As well as being picked second in the preseason poll, Robert Morris placed senior forward **A.J. Jackson** on the 2006-07 NEC preseason all-conference team. Joining Jackson are forwards Marques Alston of Monmouth and Obie Nwadike of Central Connecticut State and guards Jarrid Frye of Sacred Heart and James Williams of Long Island.

Conducted annually, NEC coaches have failed to correctly forecast the eventual league champion since selecting Mount St. Mary's to win it all in 1998-99, and have proven inaccurate in 17 of the last 19 years.

This year marks the eighth time that Monmouth has been selected the Northeast Conference's preseason favorite by league head coaches, the most in conference history by a wide margin.

The Need for Three

The Colonials have relied heavily on the three-point shot under the direction of **Mark Schmidt** during his six years as head coach, with evidence the club's three-point field goal totals. In 2005-06 RMU shattered the team record for three-pointers with 260, eclipsing the club's old mark of 213, which was set in 2003-04. On the 2005-06 campaign, RMU averaged 8.97 three-pointers a game to lead the Northeast Conference. Since the start of the 2001-02 season, the Colonials lead the NEC in three-pointers made per game (7.46), ahead of St. Francis (N.Y.), which has averaged 7.02 three-pointers a contest.
