Top Story - The **Robert Morris University** men's basketball team begins its quest for a leaguerecord sixth Northeast Conference championship Thursday night when it hosts Mount St. Mary's for a 7:30 p.m. NEC Tournament quarterfinal game at the Charles L. Sewall Center. The Colonials enter the contest as the No. 4 seed, while Mount St. Mary's is seeded fifth. RMU is making its 23rd appearance in the NEC Tournament and fifth in six seasons under head coach **Mark Schmidt**. All-time in tournament action Robert Morris owns a record of 22-17, including a record of 2-4 under Schmidt. In NEC Tournament home games, the Colonials enter Thursday's contest with a record of 14-4, including a 9-3 mark in postseason tilts at the Sewall Center.

Quick Stat of the Night - Robert Morris enters the 2007 NEC Tournament Thursday riding its best offensive stretch of the 2006-07 campaign, as in the last five games the club has averaged 83.8 points per game while shooting 51.7 percent (155-for-300) from the field. A key reason for the surge has been that a different Colonial has stepped up their offensive production on a given night. Junior guard Tony Lee (31 points vs. SFNY), sophomore guard Jeremy Chappell (31 @ CCSU) and senior guard A.J. Jackson (34 vs. LIU) have each eclipsed the 30-point plateau in the last five games, the first time in school history three different Colonials have turned the trick a five-game stretch.

Thursday's Opponent and the All-Time Series -

RMU and Mount St. Mary's will tipoff for the 40th time Thursday night, with the Mount holding a 22-17 edge in the all-time series. The two clubs will also meet for the fourth time in NEC Tournament play Thursday, with Robert Morris having won two of the previous three

contests. Included in that is a 67-66 win over the Mount in the 2006 NEC Tournament quarterfinals at Knott Arena (3/2/06). Thursday's tilt will be the sixth time the two clubs have met in the last two years, with the previous five games having been decided by a total of 12 points.

Head Coach Mark Schmidt Sixth Season - Boston College '85



The 2006-07 campaign marks **Mark Schmidt's** sixth year as head coach of the men's basketball program at Robert Morris University. He owns an overall record of 82-89 (.480), including a 58-52 (.527) mark in the Northeast Conference, and was named to his current post May 7, 2001. Schmidt guided the Colonials to their first winning season in six years in 2005-06 with an overall record of 15-14, including 10-8 in conference action. He also led RMU to the NEC Tournament semifinals for the second time in the last three years in 2006. In 2003-04 and 2004-05, he led RMU to identical overall

records of 14-15. In 2001-02, Schmidt led Robert Morris to a 12-18 overall record, the most victories for a first-year head coach in the 30-year history of the Colonial men's basketball program.

Prior to RMU, Schmidt spent seven seasons as one of the nation's top assistants at Xavier University under current Wake Forest head coach Skip Prosser from 1994-2001. While with the Musketeers, Schmidt played a dual role, serving as both a coach and the program's top recruiter. His coaching responsibilities centered mostly around the post players, and he helped develop and recruit players at Xavier that have moved on to the professional ranks, including James Posey (Miami Heat), David West (New Orleans Hornets), Romain Sato (San Antonio Spurs), Lionel Chalmers (Minnesota Timberwolves) and David Young (Seattle Supersonics). Prior to his stint with Xavier, Schmidt served one year as an assistant at Loyola College in Baltimore, Md., also under Prosser. He also spent two seasons at Penn State University under Bruce Parkhill from 1991-93, and started his coaching career as an assistant at St. Michael's College in Vermont from 1989-91.

Schmidt's playing career was highlighted by four years as a guard/forward at Boston College, where he received his bachelor's degree in business administration and management with a concentration in marketing in 1985. The Eagles went 22-10 and made the NCAA Elite Eight during his freshman season in 1981-82 under head coach Tom Davis and 25-7 the next year in making the NCAA Tournament Sweet Sixteen in his first of three years playing for current Maryland coach Gary Williams. Boston College reached the NIT second round in 1984 and the NCAA Sweet Sixteen again in 1985.

Scouting the Mount - Mount St. Mary's enters Thursday's NEC Tournament quarterfinal game with RMU Thursday with an overall record of 10-19 and has dropped four of its last five and six of its last eight games entering the postseason fray. The leading scorer for the Mount has been junior guard Chris Vann, who scores at a 13.3 points per game clip and leads the club with 59 three-pointers. Freshman guard Jeremy Goode ranks fourth in the NEC in assists (4.97 per game) as well as third in steals (1.90 per game) while owning a scoring average of 10.2 points per contest. The leading rebounder for Mount St. Mary's is senior guard Mychal Kearse, who owns an average of 5.7 per tilt. The Mount has allowed just 68.4 points per game so far this season, which ranks third in the league.

Mount St. Mary's Head Coach - The 2006-07 campaign is the fourth season for head coach Milan Brown (Howard '93) on the sidelines at Mount St. Mary's. He enters Thursday's game with an overall record of 40-75 (.348), including a mark of 33-39 (.458) in the NEC.

RMU's Last Game - Senior forward A.J. Jackson recorded his second consecutive doubledouble, and seventh of the 2006-07 campaign, with a season high 34 points and a game high 12 rebounds to help Robert Morris to a 90-74 win over Long Island Feb 26. The victory, coupled with a Fairleigh Dickinson loss at St. Francis (N.Y.), 72-69, boosted RMU into a fourth place tie in the Northeast Conference standings and a home game in 2007 NEC Tournament. Against the Blackbirds, RMU used a 17-5 run late in the second half to turn a 59-59 deadlock into a 74-64 edge with 3:31 to play, and the Colonials finished 10-for-10 from the free-throw line in the last 1:42 to help seal the victory. During the surge Jackson scored eight points, including a pair of three-pointers, while sophomore guard Jeremy Chappell added five points. Senior guard Derek Coleman helped seal the victory by going 8-for-8 from the charity stripe in the last 1:42 of action and was 10-for-10 from the line on the game. In the first half the Colonials jumped out to an 11-4 advantage as Jackson scored eight points, but RMU then went cold offensively, allowing Long Island to score eight straight points to take a 12-11 lead. Robert Morris missed its first nine three-point attempts on the night and finished just 3-for-14 (21.4 percent) from long range in the first half. The Blackbirds eventually stretched their lead to 18-13 after a three-pointer from Eugene Kotorobai, and the LIU advantage eventually swelled to eight, 27-19, with 6:53 left before halftime after another trifecta from Kotorobai. Robert Morris reeled off eight straight points to knot the score at 27-27 and eventually entered the break with a 37-33 lead after a pair of free throws from Coleman with six seconds left on the first-half clock. Jackson finished 14-for-21 from the field and 2-for-2 from the free-throw line for his 34 points while also adding 12 rebounds, two assists and three blocks. Coleman contributed 21 points, four rebounds and six assists, while Chappell, despite an 0-for-7 performance from beyond the arc, finished with 15 points. James Williams paced LIU with 24 points and dished out six assists, while Kotorobai added 22 and nine rebounds.

Coleman in 2006-07: @ Fairleigh Dickinson (1/13/07), 5-for-7 ... vs. Sacred Heart (1/18/07), 5-for-10 ... **Chappell in 2006-07:** @ Central Connecticut State (2/22/07), 6-for-11 Long Island Game Notes - Junior guard Tony Lee was held to nine points but added six assists as he played only 27 minutes due to foul trouble ... As a club Robert Morris shot 51.6 percent (32-for-62) from the field, including 56.3 percent (18-for-32) in the second half ... LIU finished with a shooting percentage of 33.3 percent (19for-57) and hit on only 29 percent (9-for-31) of its field goal attempts after halftime ... RMU outscored the Blackbirds, 42-12, in points in the paint ... The Colonials posted 20 assists on their 32 field goals.

The Jackson Five - Senior forward **AJ. Jackson** enters the 2007 NEC Tournament coming off one of his best performances of the 2006-07 season, leading the way in a 90-74 victory over Long Island (2/26/07) with his 21st career double-double thanks to a season high 34 points and 12 rebounds. Jackson enters Thursday's game with the Mount have scored in double figures in **eight** straight games, averaging **17.6** points and **8.0** rebounds a contest over that span while shooting **54.3** percent (**50-for-92**) from the field.

Forever in Lee Blue Jeans - Junior guard **Tony Lee** has been as consistent a player for Robert Morris this season and has seemingly saved his basketball for the stretch run of the 2006-07 campaign. Despite finishing with just nine points in a 90-74 win over Long Island (2/26/07), in the last **10** games Lee has averaged **18.8** points, **5.7** rebounds and **4.7** assists per contest while shooting **57.6** percent (**68-for-118**) from the field.

The Patriot - Any success Robert Morris will have in the 2007 NEC Tournament will depend in large part to the play of senior guard **Derek Coleman**. A natural playmaker, the Boston, Mass., product has also increased his offensive production since the calendar has switched to the year 2007. In **16** games since returning to league play, Coleman is averaging **14.7** points per contest while shooting **46.3** percent (**75for-162**) from the floor. Even with the increased offensive output, it hasn't slowed Coleman down in creating opportunities for his teammates. In the same stretch Coleman is averaging **5.8** assists per game.

Double Nickel on a Dime - Junior guard **Tony Lee** tied for game high honors in assists with six in a 90-74 win over Long Island (2/26/07), the 12th time this season he has either led or tied for the team lead in dimes in a game. Lee pushed his season total in the category to 120, second on the club behind senior guard **Derek Coleman** (148). Coleman and Lee are the first **pair** of RMU teammates to post at least **100** assists in a season since the **1990-91** campaign, when Andre Boyd (137) and Wade Timmerson (126) turned the trick. Coleman and Lee are also just the **third** pair **overall** to accomplish the feat, joining former guards Forest Grant and Chipper Harris, who each finished with at least 100 assists in three straight seasons from 1981 to 1984.

Offensively Speaking - Robert Morris enters the 2007 NEC Tournament having seemingly hit its stride offensively, as the club has shot a solid **50.3** percent (**539**-**for-1,071**) from the field in its last **19** games. Over that span the Colonials have shot 50 percent or better from the field **12** times. Due to the surge, RMU owns a team shooting percentage of **48.1** percent (**747-for-1,552**) on the season, which leads the Northeast Conference. The Colonials have never lead the league in field goal percentage in 26 years as part of the conference.

Coleman's Court - Senior guard **Derek Coleman** enters the 2007 NEC Tournament leading the league in assists with an average of **5.48** per game, a total that also ranks 28th in Division I. He's trying to become just the **third** player in league history to lead the circuit in assists in back-to-back years and first since Monmouth's Rahsaan Johnson in 2000-01 (5.7 apg) and 2001-02 (5.3 apg). Former St. Francis (N.Y.) guard Greg Nunn posted averages of 5.6 and 6.1 assists per game, respectively, in 1998-99 and 1999-2000. Coleman led the NEC last year in assists per game (4.7). Drafton Davis of Marist is also a two-time assist leader in the NEC, as he paced the circuit with an average of 8.0 in 1985-86 before leading the league two years later with an average of 7.7 in 1987-88.

Both Ends of the Floor - Junior guard **Tony Lee** has been the most complete player for Robert Morris in 2006-07, and the evidence is in the numbers. Offensively, Lee is second on the team in scoring (16.1 ppg) while pacing the Northeast Conference in field goal percentage (.600). Defensively, Lee also leads the circuit in steals by averaging 2.78 per game. In the national rankings through games of Feb. 25, 2007, Lee ranks sixth in Division I in steals, while his field goal percentage ranks 23rd. He is one of just two players from an NEC school to rank in the 25 top in two categories, joining Central Connecticut State guard Tristan Blackwood. A look at the numbers ...

Triple Threat - Thanks to 21 points @ Quinnipiac (2/24/07) and eclipsing the 1,000-point plateau for his career, junior guard **Tony Lee** eclipsed a milestone few have accomplished in the history of the Northeast Conference. With career totals of 1,017 points, 523 rebounds and 266 assists, Lee is just the sixth player in league history, and second this season, to eclipse career totals of 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 250 assists. Lee joins Jarrid Frye of Sacred Heart, who joined the club when grabbing his 500th rebound Feb. 10 against Wagner. Lee is also the first player in league history to go over those thresholds during his junior season.

Combination Platter - So far this season, Robert Morris has received 79.6 percent of its offense from its usual contributors in guards **Derek Coleman**, **Tony Lee** and **Jeremy Chappell** and forward **A.J. Jackson**. Despite that, dating back to the start of the 2005-06 campaign, when Coleman and Jackson combine to score more than 30 points in a game, the Colonials own a record of **19-6** (.760). Included in that is a mark of **10-3** so far this season.

Zoom Zoom - Junior guard Tony Lee picked up his 500th career rebound in RMU's 71-63 win over Wagner (2/18/07) when he finished with eight. Lee entered the game needing just three rebounds for 500 and now owns 523 for his career entering the 2007 Northeast Conference Tournament. Lee also tied the school record for fastest to 500 rebounds, as he accomplished the feat in his 81st career game. RMU's all-time leading rebounder, Anthony Dickens, also notched his 500th career carom in his 81st career game, a 70-59 victory @ Niagara (11/29/89).

Mr. Perfect - Junior guard **Tony Lee** certainly could be looked at as RMU's most valuable player as the club owns a record of 17-10 in 2006-07, and he probably was never more valuable in a game than in an 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/06). Lee finished a perfect 8-for-8 from the field, including 1-for-1 from beyond the arc, in scoring 17 points while adding a team high seven rebounds, four assists and two steals. The only other perfect day for a Robert Morris player on record with more than five field goal attempts was former Colonial Bubba Donnelly (1991-95), who finished 7-for-7 from the field for 21 points in an 80-59 win @ Rider (1/10/94). All seven of Donnelly's field goals in that game were three-pointers.

In 2006-07 Robert Morris posted a record of 8-1 in nonconference games, tying a school record for out-ofleague wins while establishing a school and Northeast Conference record for winning percentage in such games. Joining the Club - By draining a trio of three-pointers in RMU's 9-74 victory over Long Island (2/26/07) in the club's 2006-07 regular-season finale, senior guard Derek Coleman pushed his career total for three-pointers to 201. The total ranks fifth all-time at Robert Morris, and Coleman becomes the fifth player in school history to tally at least 200 three-pointers on his career. In all in the Colonial record book, three of the top five leaders in three-point field goals have come under the guidance of sixth-year head coach Mark Schmidt. Joining Coleman is former forward Aaron Thomas, who finished with a school record 218 from 2000 to 2004, and former guard Maurice Carter, who tallied 217 trifecta's from 2001 to 2005.

The Strokes - Despite having his consecutive streak of free throws snapped at 13 in a 76-68 win over Saint Francis (Pa.) (2/3/07), senior guard **Derek Coleman** still has shot **90** percent (**36**-for-**40**) from the free-throw line in his last 11 games. Coleman's run marked his second double-digit streak of the 2006-07 campaign, as he hit 17 straight over a seven-game span in December and January. Coleman currently ranks tied for second in the Northeast Conference with a free-throw percentage of **87.5** percent (**70-for-80**) and could possibly be making runs at both the single-season and career records for free throw shooting. The single-season mark is held by former Colonial Brandon Welsch, who converted 87.7 percent (71-for-81) of his shots in 1998-99. The career record of 86 percent is held by former Colonial Tom Parks (1978-83). Coleman enters the 2007 NEC Tournament with a career free-throw shooting percentage of 83.4 percent (191-for-229), which ranks third in the career record book at Robert Morris.

Select Company - Senior forward **A.J. Jackson**, a 2006-07 preseason All-Northeast Conference Team selection, put together one of his best games in a Colonial uniform in RMU's 73-69 win @ Marshall (11/17/06). Jackson finished with 30 points on 9-of-18 shooting and also compiled 15 rebounds, including six offensive boards, for his 15th career double-double. In RMU's 2006-07 regular season finale, Jackson scored a season high 34 points to pace the club in a 90-74 win over Long Island (2/26/07), marking the third time he has hit the 30-point plateau in a contest. A quick glance at the Robert Morris single-game records, and Jackson has an opportunity to post the most 30-point scoring games in school history and is already tied for the most games with 15+ rebounds. Former Colonial Myron Walker (1991-94) posted six games in which he scored 30 or more points, while former Colonials Earl Cureton (1976-77) and Anthony Dickens (1985-90) own three games of posting at least 15 rebounds in a game. Clutch Shooting - A number of Colonials have begun to show their penchant for clutch shooting late in ball games as Robert Morris enters the 2007 NEC Tournament. In a 73-69 victory @ Marshall (11/17/06) in the club's first road game of the season, senior forward **A.J. Jackson** and senior guard **Derek Coleman** each hit three-pointers in the last 1:35 of the contest to help propel the Colonials to victory. Coleman's three-pointer with 49 seconds to go gave Robert Morris the lead for good, and it marks his second career three-pointer in the last minute of a game that gave the Colonials a lead. Coleman drained a three-pointer with 12 seconds to play to lift RMU to a 69-68 victory @ Central Connecticut State (2/14/04) during his freshman campaign. Sophomore guard **Jeremy Chappell**, meanwhile, sunk a three-pointer with 12.3 seconds remaining to lift Robert Morris to a 67-66 win @ Mount St. Mary's (3/3/06) in the 2006 NEC Tournament quarterfinals.

Straight Shooter - Junior guard **Tony Lee** hit his first six shots from the field in RMU's 83-38 win over Goucher (12/30/06) before missing a three-pointer with a minute to go in the first half. With that missed trifecta it ended a streak of 16 straight field goals for Lee dating back to the club's 79-78 win over Youngstown State (12/16/06). Lee hit his last two field goals against the Penguins, all eight of his shots in an 81-77 win @ Canisius (12/20/06) before hitting his first six shots from the floor against the Gophers.

Running With the Devil - Robert Morris has played some close ball games so far on the 2006-07 season, with the Colonials coming out on top. In games decided by five points or less RMU boasts a record of 7-5, including a pair of one-point victories. That mark has helped Robert Morris improve to 28-23 (.549) under sixth-year head coach **Mark Schmidt** in games decided by five points or less. However, basketball is a game of runs, and that has never been more prudent than with Robert Morris in 2006-07. In 22 of RMU's 27 games so far this season, the Colonials have either owned a double-digit lead or trailed by double digits.

Iron Man - Senior guard **Derek Coleman** doesn't get comfortable sitting on the bench during games. In fact, he rarely is off the court at all. Coleman enters the 2007 NEC Tournament having played a full contest in 14 of the club's 27 games this season, and in two other contests he has logged 39 minutes. It's a trend that hasn't subsided for RMU's floor general since he became a regular starter for the club at the end of his freshman season. Coleman has played a full game's worth of action a total of 36 times in his Robert Morris career, including a 48-minute stint against St. Francis (N.Y.) (2/17/07). Since earning his first start against Sacred Heart back on Feb. 5, 2004, Coleman has averaged 35.7 minutes per game in 95 starts.

Making It Count - An area of strength for RMU under the direction of head coach Mark Schmidt has been the ability of the team to convert at the free-throw line. Robert Morris has finished in the top five in the Northeast Conference in free-throw percentage each of the previous five years, including a league-best 75.4 percent (384-for-576) in 2003-04. So far this season the Colonials lead the circuit in free throw percentage, converting **75.6** percent (**353-for-467**) of their opportunities. Robert Morris has been even better in pressure situations, converting a solid **82.2** percent (**120-for-146**) of its shots in the last five minutes and overtime of games. Senior guard **Derek Coleman** and senior forward **A.J.** Jackson have been at the stripe the most in crunch time, combining to hit 62 of their 71 opportunities (87.3 percent).

Pop Goes the Weasel - Junior guard **Tony Lee** was all over the court in RMU's 73-72 win over Duquesne (12/2/06), especially on defense. Lee broke a 19-year old Charles L. Sewall Center record for steals by registering eight against the Dukes, including three in the last 12:07 as RMU climbed out of a 10-point deficit. Lee's eight steals eclipsed the old record of seven, which was originally established by Drafton Davis of Marist. Davis recorded his seven thefts in a 61-57 overtime victory over the Colonials Feb. 28, 1987. Lee's eight steals is the seventh highest singlegame total of the 2006-07 season in Division I, behind Travis Holmes of VMI (11 steals), Ledell Eackles of Campbell (10 steals) and Darren Collison of UCLA, Damian Martin of Loyola Marymount, Chavis Holmes of VMI and Kevin Bell of Fresno State, who each have posted nine steals.

Creating & Creating - Senior guard **Derek Coleman** has done a solid job this year doing what he does best: creating opportunities for his teammates. Coleman dished out six assists in a 76-68 win over Saint Francis (Pa.) (2/3/07) to push his career total to 404, becoming just the sixth Colonial in school history with 400 career dimes and the first since Javier Smith finished with 459 from 1994-98. Coleman currently is tops in the Northeast Conference in assists per game (5.48) and is on pace to finish the 2006-07 season with 441 dimes, which would rank fourth all-time at Robert Morris.

Spread The Jam - One of the strengths for Robert Morris on the 2006-07 campaign has been the club's ability to be unselfish, and it's a trend that has continued as the Colonials enter postseason play. In the last 19 contests RMU has converted a total of 539 field goals, with the club posting assists on 314 of those baskets. That equates to almost 60 percent (58.3) of the club's field goals. As a club so far this year Robert Morris is averaging **16.26** assists per game, which **leads** the Northeast Conference. The highest assist per game average by RMU in the six-year tenure of head coach **Mark Schmidt** is 15.2 dimes per contest, set in Schmidt's inaugural season as head coach in 2001-02.

Daytona 500 - Junior guard **Tony Lee** became the 13th member of the Robert Morris 500-rebound club in RMU's 71-63 victory over Wagner (2/18/07) when he finished with eight boards, pushing his career total to 505. Lee is the fourth Colonial in six years to eclipse the 500-rebound plateau under head coach Mark Schmidt, joining Matt Smith (1998-2002), Aaron Thomas (2000-04) and Chaz McCrommon (2000-05). Thanks to an average of 6.2 rebounds per game this season, Lee is on pace to finish the 2006-07 season with 529 rebounds, which would rank 10th all-time.

The Chase Is On - For the second time in three seasons, the Robert Morris career record for three-point field goals could be challenged in 2006-07. Former Colonial Aaron Thomas (2000-04) established a new career record for three-pointers in 2003-04 by finishing his career with 218. That record was only 48 treys ahead of former Colonial Maurice Carter (2001-05) entering the 2004-05 campaign, but Carter hit just 47 in his senior season to finish second in the record books with 217 career three-pointers. Now, thanks to a career high 74 three-pointers in 2005-06, senior **Derek Coleman** entered his final season in 2006-07 a total of 78 three-pointers so far on the 2006-07 season, pushing his career total to 201, which ranks fifth all-time at RMU. With at least one game remaining in 2006-07, Coleman needs 18 three-pointers to eclipse the record of 218 held by Thomas.

Home Is Where the Heart Is - Senior forward A.J. Jackson has found the Charles L. Sewall Center to his liking. Dating back to the start of the 2005-06 campaign, Jackson has been as solid a player as any for the Colonials at home, averaging 18.8 points and 9.3 rebounds in 27 career games at the Sewall Center. Jackson became just the second Colonial in school history to average over 20 points per game at home last season when he scored at a 20.8 points per game clip. The only other Colonial to average over 20 points per contest in a season in the Sewall Center's 22-year history was RMU all-time leading scorer Myron Walker (1990-94), who averaged 21.1 points per game as a sophomore in 1991-92. Jackson also has an opportunity to post the best career scoring average by a Colonial at the Sewall Center. That mark is also held by Walker at 18.5 points per game. Marshall Memorial Classic

Home Sweet Home - Robert Morris has learned to protect its home court at the Charles L. Sewall Center, as the Colonials notched a 96-72 win in its 2006-07 season opener over Florida International at home, a year after posting an 11-2 record at home. Thanks to an 11-3 record at the Sewall Center so far this season, RMU has posted a record of 52-26 (.667) at the home under sixth-year head coach Mark Schmidt. Overall in the 22-year history of the facility the Colonials have posted a record of 175-107 (.621).

Four on the Floor - Senior forward **A.J. Jackson** had his streak of 20+ point scoring games snapped at four when he finished with just eight points @ Monmouth (1/27/07). Despite that, it marked Jackson's second such streak of the 2006-07 season. In RMU's 4-0 start to the year, Jackson averaged 24.0 points per game and eclipsed the 20-point plateau in each contest. He became the first Colonial in school history to post a pair of streaks of at least four games scoring 20+ points in the same season and just the second player to turn the trick overall. Former Colonial Gene Nabors (1995-2000) also accomplished the feat twice, turning the trick in each of the 1998-99 and 1999-2000 campaigns. Jackson is also just the fifth player in school history to score at least 20 points in four straight games overall, as joining him and Nabors are former Colonials Myron Walker (1990-94), Keith Jones (1995-99) and Wesley Fluellen (1997-2002). Nabors is also the only Colonial in school history to have more than four games of scoring 20+ points in a contest, as he averaged 27.1 points over eight straight games late in the 1999-2000 season. The streak was tied for the third longest by a Colonial on the active roster, and it also tied Lee's career-best streak. He scored in double figures in 11 straight contests from Jan. 26, 2006 to March 2, 2006. Senior forward **A.J. Jackson** currently owns the longest double-figure scoring streak, which is eight games.

According to a poll of league head coaches, Robert Morris was been picked to finish second in the Northeast Conference in 2006-07. It marks the highest preseason ranking for the Colonials ever, matching their second-place preseason prediction prior to the 1991-92 campaign. RMU received five firstplace votes, with the other six going to Monmouth, which was tabbed as the preseason favorite.

Following Monmouth and Robert Morris in the top five in the poll are Long Island, Central Connecticut State and Quinnipiac. The Blue Devils and Bobcats were picked to tie for fourth in the poll. Rounding out the annual poll is Wagner, Fairleigh Dickinson, St. Francis (N.Y.), Sacred Heart, Mount St. Mary's and Saint Francis (Pa.).

As well as being picked second in the preseason poll, Robert Morris placed senior forward **A.J. Jackson** on the 2006-07 NEC preseason all-conference team. Joining Jackson are forwards Marques Alston of Monmouth and Obie Nwadike of Central Connecticut State and guards Jarrid Frye of Sacred Heart and James Williams of Long Island.

Conducted annually, NEC coaches have failed to correctly forecast the eventual league champion since selecting Mount St. Mary's to win it all in 1998-99, and have proven inaccurate in 17 of the last 19 years.

This year marks the eighth time that Monmouth has been selected the Northeast Conference's preseason favorite by league head coaches, the most in conference history by a wide margin.

The Need for Three

The Colonials have relied heavily on the three-point shot under the direction of Mark Schmidt during his six years as head coach, with evidence the club's three-point field goal totals. In 2005-06 RMU shattered the team record for three-pointers with 260, eclipsing the club's old mark of 213, which was set in 2003-04. On the 2005-06 campaign, RMU averaged 8.97 three-pointers a game to lead the Northeast Conference. Since the start of the 2001-02 season, the Colonials lead the NEC in three-pointers made per game (7.47), ahead of Fairleigh Dickinson, which has averaged 6.97 three-pointers a contest. Robert Morris owns an all-time record of 22-17 in NEC Tournament history, with the 22 wins ranking second in conference history to Fairleigh Dickinson (27) ... Broken down, the Colonials own a record of 14-4 in tournament games played at home, including a record of 9-3 in games at the Charles L. Sewall Center, 3-6 in road games and a mark of 5-7 in neutral site contests ... Jeremy Chappell averaged 19.5 points and 6.0 rebounds in two games of the 2006 NEC Tournament to earn All-NEC Tournament Team accolades, the first Colonial under head coach Mark Schmidt to earn the honor and 10th overall ... Senior guard Derek Coleman has the most posteason experience of any player on the RMU roster, having appeared in five games and averaging 6.4 points and 4.2 assists over that span ... In three career games in the NEC Tournament, junior guard Tony Lee has posted averages of 10.7 points, 7.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.7 steals ... Senior forward A.J.
