

ResNet Self-Help Guide: Finding the MAC Address in Mac OS X

Apple Mac OS X

OS X:

1. Click the **Apple menu** and select “**System Preferences**”.
2. Under “Internet & Wireless”, select “**Network**”.
 - If Network Preferences is locked, click on the lock icon in the lower left, and enter the Admin password to make further changes.
3. Choose the correct **network interface**, and click “**Advanced**”. The MAC address is shown at the bottom.

Command-line:

1. Open the **Terminal** (Command+Space, start typing “terminal”)
2. Type “**ifconfig**” and press enter.
3. Locate the correct network adapter. The MAC address should be labeled as “ether”.
