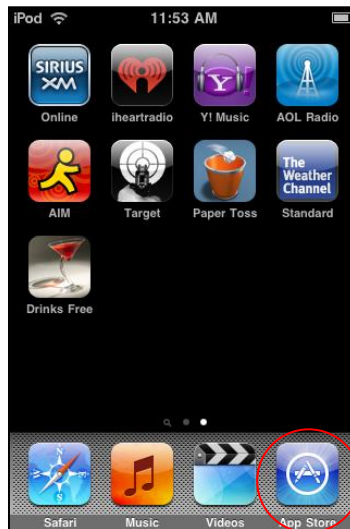


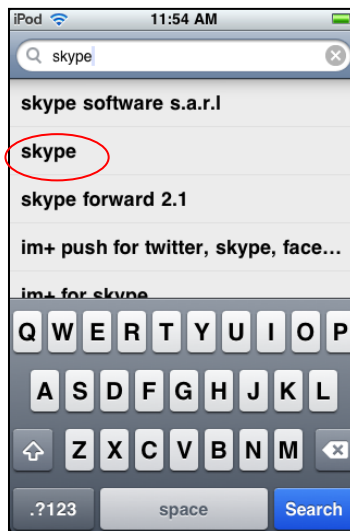
Using the iPod as a phone via Skype

Revision 1 (8/10/2009)

1) Click the “App Store” icon.



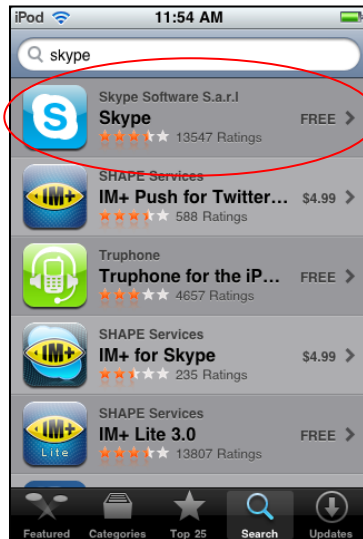
2) Type in “Skype” and click on it when it appears in the list.

3) Click “Skype” from the list.



4) Click the “FREE” button to install the Skype App.



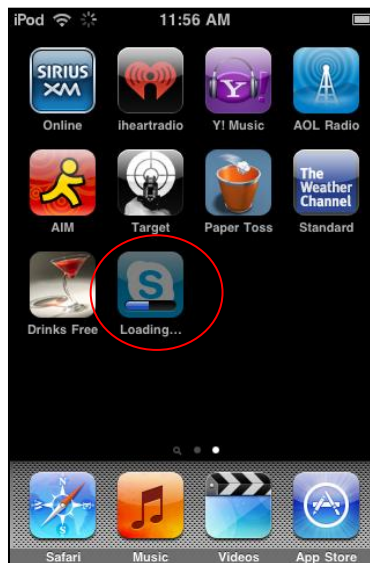

5) Then click the “INSTALL” button to install the app.



6) You will be returned to the main iPod navigation screen and will see that Skype is loading / installing.



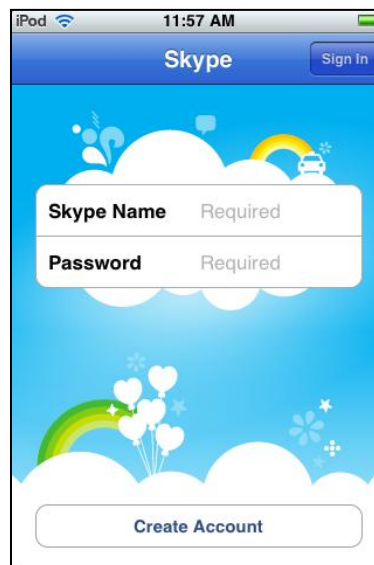

7) Eventually the Skype will install and the loading caption will go away. Click on the Skype icon to load the program.



8) You can sign-in with one you already have OR you can create a new account.



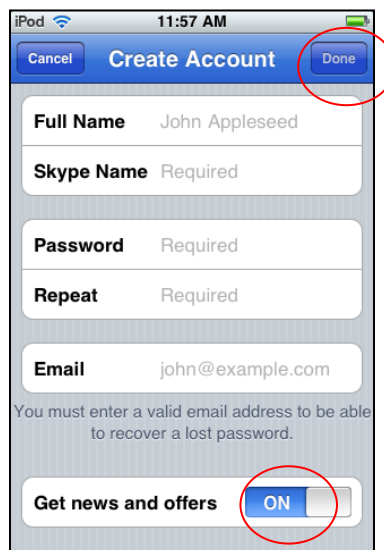

9) If you create a new account, you must click “Accept” to agree with the “No Emergency Calls” agreement.



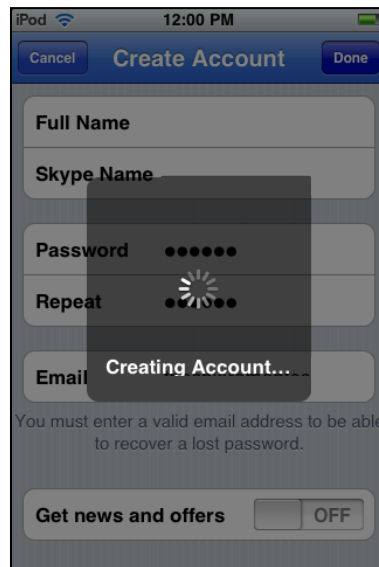
10) You must fill in the information shown below. You have the option to disable notifications of offers and news if you want. Once you have filled in the requirements, click the “Done” button.



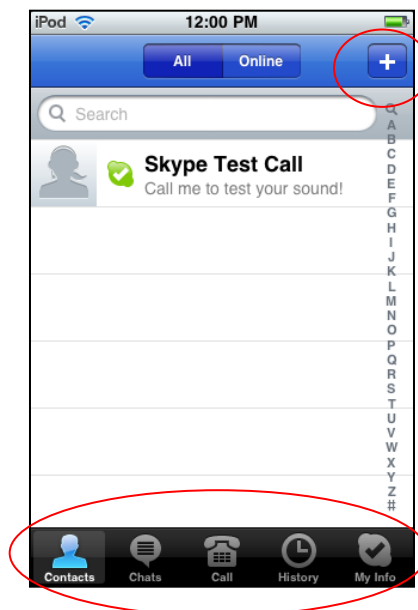

11) The screen will become grayed-out and Skype attempt to create the username and password you specified. If the user name is already taken, simply type a new one and click the “Done” button again.



12) You will be taken to the “Contacts” screen of Skype, where you can add or remove contacts and much more.

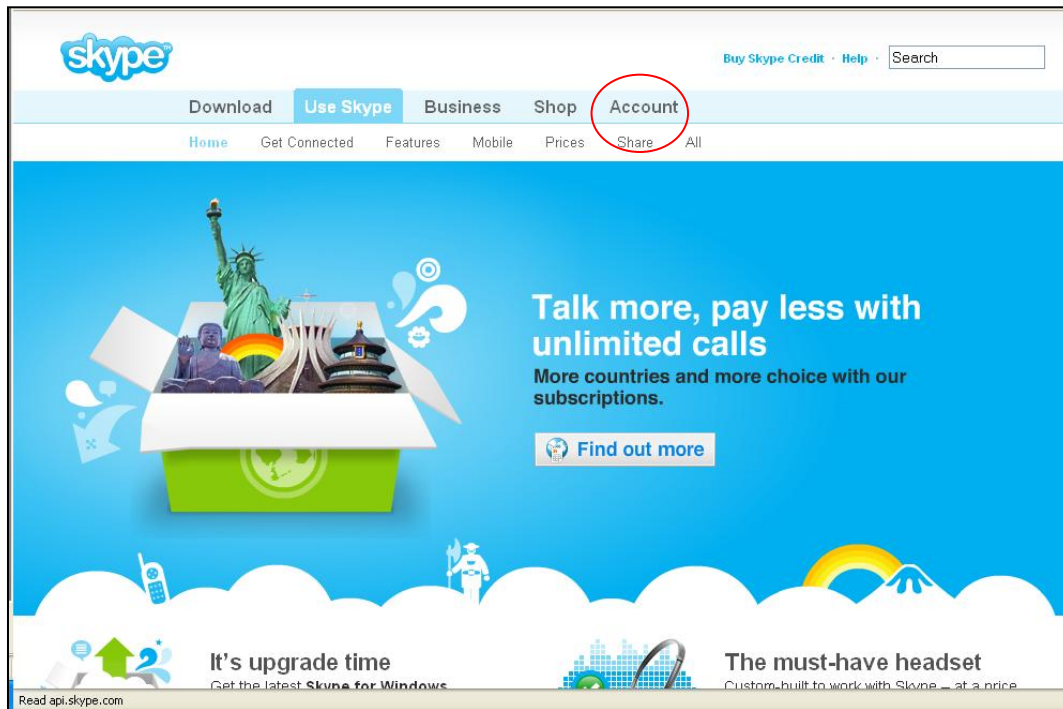


****You can now communicate with other Skype members via the Internet for free. However, there are plans that you can purchase and will enable you to use your iPod Touch as a phone capable of voicemail, sending and receiving calls, and also sending and receiving sms text messages from other cell phones.****

Using the iTouch as a phone via Skype

13) Go to <http://www.skype.com> and click on “Account” at the top right to login with the Skype account you created.



14) Once you are logged into Skype, you can pick the plan that best suits your needs. After purchasing a plan, your account should be updated and enabled to make phone calls or send sms text messages from your iPod Touch. **You may have to restart the Skype App on your iPod OR restart the iPod itself before using the program and features.**
