

ResNet Quick Guide: Finding the MAC Address in Windows

Microsoft Windows

Windows XP:

1. Open "**Network Connections**" (right-click the network icon in the taskbar, or go through the Control Panel).
2. Right-click the network interface, and click "**Status**".
3. Click the "**Support**" tab, and click "**Details**". The MAC address is labeled as "Physical Address".

Windows Vista/7/8:

1. Open the "**Network and Sharing Center**" (right-click the network icon in the taskbar, or go through the Control Panel).
2. Click "**Change adapter settings**" on the left side.
3. Double-click on the network interface, and click "**Details**". The MAC address is labeled as "Physical Address".

Command-line:

1. Run command prompt (Windows+R, type "cmd")
2. Type "ipconfig /all" and press enter
3. Locate the correct network adapter. The MAC address is labeled as "Physical Address".
