## Course Information

### **ARTM3390 "Photography Study Abroad" (3 credits)**

In an increasing global society travel to any part of the world has become easier and more accessible. In this course students will learn to create unique and compelling photographs while traveling outside of the United States in a faculty-led excursion. They will learn about shooting landscapes, nature, and people while learning the culture, history, and heritage of another country.

### **HUMA1011 "Humanities Abroad" (3 credits)**

This course will serve as an introduction to the fine arts in Ireland. We will explore the characteristics, style, classification, form, and content of art through critical analysis and relationship to historical events. The student will gain the tools necessary to evaluate art and will then be able to apply these tools, including a critical approach, to other areas and subjects outside of this course. It is the main objective of the course to aid in the development of the student's ability to think critically.

## Cost

The \$3,500 program fee includes: airfare, housing, most meals, mandatory excursions (for example, museum fees, company visits, historical sites), and supplementary travel insurance.

The fee does not include: personal spending money, some meals, elective (free time) excursions, passport fees, overweight baggage fees.

The tuition for this course is covered by your Spring 2019 tuition payment (if taking between 12-18 credits).
