



# ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR HIGH SCHOOL APPLICANTS

All nursing applicants must submit an application to the RMU Admissions Office.

The following academic courses are required for admission:

<b>Course</b>	<b>Units</b>
English	4
Algebra	1
Additional Math	1
Social Studies	3
Science with a related laboratory <b>(one must be Chemistry)</b>	2
Academic Electives	5
	<b>16 Units</b>

The following are required for admission to the nursing program:

- Official transcripts from high school indicating graduation (or equivalency) and any post-secondary institutions attended.
- Minimum SAT score of 1080 (Reading and Writing and Math combined) or ACT score of 22
- Minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Successful completion of Chemistry course with a lab (documented on an academic transcript)
- Grades of B or better in math and science courses

Applications may be subject to review on an individual basis within the Department of Nursing
