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The HVA as referenced in Section II of this plan contains a list of “incident specific” conditions/emergencies that have been assessed for risk to the university. Subsequently, incident specific protocols have been developed based on risk priority. Below is a summary of incident specific protocols (TAB’s), which a written protocol has been developed and can be found:

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Section V- Business Continuity and Support Services:

A Business Continuity Plan (BCP) is a document that consists of critical information an organization needs to continue operating during an unplanned event. As such, individual plans or guidance documents have been established identifying some essential functions and detailing how these functions will be maintained. In addition, a number of services or functions may be necessary to support the overall operations and ancillary impacts resulting from an unplanned event. Below is a summary of specific guidance documents and support plans, which can be found in Section V of this ERP.

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
