Academic Requirements for Program Progression Pre-licensure BSN Program

Students enrolled in the pre-licensure BSN program must meet the following criteria in order to progress in the major:

- 1. Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.67 or better each semester.
- 2. Achieve a final course grade of B- or better in the *required courses in the nursing major* noted below:
 - a. Major, Nursing
 - All courses with the NURS prefix
 - b. Major Foundation, Nursing
 - BIOL1050; BIOL1210/1215; BIOL1220/1225; BIOL2370/2380; PSYC3550
- 3. Achieve a minimum 80% examination average on exams in courses with the NURS prefix. Students should refer to the course syllabus for additional information and details related to grading.
- 4. Achieve a passing grade in all clinical courses in the major. Clinical courses use a P/F (pass/fail) grading scale.

The following information applies to those who do NOT meet the criteria noted above.

- Students who do not achieve a B- or better in required courses in the nursing major (as noted above) are
 permitted to repeat the course ONE time. Repeating a course will result in delayed progression and completion of
 the nursing program.
- 2. Courses with the NURS prefix must be repeated at RMU.
- 3. Students who earn an unsatisfactory grade (below B-) on the repeated attempt of a *required course in the nursing major* will be dismissed from the nursing program*.
- 4. Students who earn an unsatisfactory grade (below B-) on any TWO courses in the nursing major listed below will be dismissed from the nursing program*.

 - NURS2020/2021 Nursing Assessment and Health Promotion Theory and Lab
 - NURS2115/2116 Foundation of Nursing Practice Theory and Lab
 - NURS2130 Pharmacology for Health Professionals
 - NURS3020/3021 Management of Adult I Theory and Clinical
 - NURS3050/3051 Nursing Care of Mothers, Newborns and Families Theory and Clinical
 - NURS3055/3056 Nursing Care of Children & Families Theory and Clinical
 - NURS4014/4013 Community Health/Health Promotion Theory and Clinical
 - NURS4020/4021 Advanced Management of Adult II Theory and Clinical
 - NURS4025/4026 Nursing Care of Psychiatric Clients Theory and Clinical
 - NURS4032 Transition to Professional Nursing Clinical
 - NURS4035 NCLEX Licensure Preparation
- 5. Students who withdraw** from a *required course in the nursing major* may retake the course on a space available basis. Students are not permitted to enroll in the same course more than two times throughout the curriculum. Retaking a course following withdrawal will result in delayed progression and completion of the nursing program.

^{*} Students who are dismissed from the nursing major are permitted to remain at RMU and declare a different major. Students should contact their academic advisor and/or success coach to discuss other majors at RMU.
