How to Apply

The Virtual Student Federal Service will begin to accept student applications in July on [Open Opps](#). Students may apply for up to three internships. A maximum of 300 students may apply to each internship. Students selected for more than one internship must pick one to complete during the school year. The application includes a resume, transcript, contact information for references, and a statement of interest. If selected the internship will start in September and last throughout the school year.
