

## Global Explorers Reflection Template

A reflection is **not** a summary. A proper reflection **may** include some summarizing details to set up the reflection, but then **focuses on your own thoughts and reactions** to the event/experience. See below for a suggested template for submitting a successful reflection.

**Paragraph #1:** Introduce the event/experience. Describe the topic and ideas reflected in the event/experience.

**Paragraph #2:** Provide **your personal opinion** about the event/experience. What were your thoughts and reactions?

**Paragraph #3:** Relate the topics or ideas in the event/experience to **at least one** personal or real-world example, or to a class you have taken.

**Paragraph #4:** Conclusion

**References:** If you use any outside sources (not required), please include a complete reference.

**Length:** 250-word minimum, not including any title or headers

**Please note:** The reflection reviewers will also be evaluating for grammar and punctuation.
